These Tests are organised by the Kennel Club with the assistance of the Dukeries (Notts) Gundog Club, the GSPC North West Group and held under Kennel Club Rules, Field Trial and Gundog Working Test Regulations.

#### QUALIFICATION:

**Open Retriever** If the test is over-subscribed Preference in the Draw will be given to dogs that have received an Award or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial in the following order:

- (1) Dogs which have won an Open Gundog Working Test.
- (2) Dogs which have gained other awards at Gundog Working Tests.
- (3) Other dogs.

**Open Spaniel** Preference will be given to Spaniels that have gained an award or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial should the test be oversubscribed.

**Novice Retriever and Novice Spaniel** Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT or First in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.

**Open Hunt, Point and Retrieve** Preference will be given to dogs that have gained a place or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT, or won a Novice GWT, should the test be oversubscribed.

**Novice Hunt, Point and Retrieve** Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT or First in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations. A ballot will be held should the test be over-subscribed.

**One owner, one dog, unless all first dogs have a run with a maximum of two dogs handled by one handler in each test.**

### THE KENNEL CLUB WORKING GUNDOG CERTIFICATE

will be on offer to all handlers running in the Novice and Young Handler Tests – assessment for this certificate will be carried out by the Judges during the actual Tests. Should there be any element not covered during the main test this will be taken immediately the test has been completed.
