On a person's first appointment to judge a Senior Stake at a Championship Bloodhound Trial, the minimum conditions which apply are - A Judge must have judged at least two stakes, not at the same trial before being allowed to award a Kennel Club Bloodhound Working Trial Certificate.

A person may be approved to judge one Senior Stake in each calendar year commencing 1st January.

Documentary evidence of previous judging may be required and must be provided if called upon.
