DEFINITION OF CLASSES.

BREEDERS' COMPETITION.

The Prizes in these Classes will be awarded to the Breeders obtaining the largest number of points with Dogs bred by themselves, irrespective of whether the exhibits are their own property or not. The Dogs must be entered in their proper Classes, and points will be awarded as under to those winning prizes or receiving commendation in such Classes. In the event of a Dog entered in two Classes winning prizes or receiving commendations in both, only the highest award will count towards this competition. Breeders will not be required to nominate the Dogs bred by them, as this will be ascertained from the Catalogue, but it will be to their interest to induce any of their friends owning such Dogs to enter them, so that their chance of winning the prize may be increased. Prizes in Stud Dog Classes will not count. The fee is 10s. In filling up form, give name and address of Competitor and Class number only.

(Challenge Class Competitors that do not obtain a prize will each score 15 points for the Breeder.)

Challenge Classes.

For all Dogs and Bitches that had qualified previously to January 1st, 1893, for competition in a Champion Class or Challenge Class, and for Winners of Ten Points in Open Classes at Shows registered in or for the Kennel Club Stud Books.

Open Classes.

No Dog or Bitch will be qualified to compete in those Classes that has ever won Ten Points in Open Classes at Shows registered in or for the Kennel Club Stud Books, or that had qualified previously to January 1st, 1893, for competition in a Champion Class or Challenge Class, where Challenge Classes are provided for that breed.

N.B.—In estimating the number of points a Dog has won, a First Prize gained at any Show under Kennel Club Rules previous to January 1st, 1893, by any Dogs not fully qualified to compete in a Challenge Class, under the Old Rules, will score Two Points.

Puppy Classes.

Single Entries, not Litters, over Three Months old and not exceeding One Year old on February 10th, 1892, and not eligible for a Challenge Class.

Novice Classes.

For all Dogs and Bitches that have never won a first prize at a Show under Kennel Club Rules previous to January 1st, 1892.

B, are for those that have never won a prize except Puppy.

C, are for those who have never won a prize of any description.

Team Classes.

For four Dogs or Bitches belonging to the same owner, either or both sex. The Prize in these Classes will be the Society's Medal.

Brace Classes.

For two Dogs or Bitches belonging to the same owner, either or both sex. The Prize in these Classes will be the Society's Medal.

Stud Dog Classes.

The Merit of the Stud Dog, as an exhibit, will not be taken into consideration, but the prize will be awarded on the merit of the Dog's progeny, which must be entered in their respective Classes, but need not be the property of the owner of the Stud Dog or of any one exhibitor. Points will be awarded as in the Breeders' Competition (see above), but in the absence of the Stud Dog, the prize will not be awarded. The Prize in these Classes will be a Bronze Medal.

N.B.—All Dogs competing for Team or Brace Specials must be entered also in their respective Classes, and also the Team or Brace Class, otherwise they are not eligible to compete.

Challenge Class Prizes.

In all Challenge Classes, if there are not more than Two Entries, the Society's Silver Medal will be given for the Prize; if more than Two Entries and under Five, the First Prize will be £2; if there are Five Entries, a Second Prize of £1 will be given; and if there are Seven Entries, there will be a Third Prize of 10s.

Conditions for the "Cruft" Challenge Cups, Value 25 Guineas each.

1. The competition for these Cups shall be confined to the various breeds of Terriers and Dogs, and shall be offered for competition at such of Mr. Cruft's Terrier or other Shows as may elect, but they shall not be offered for competition less than once in each year.

2. Each Cup will be offered for the best Team of four exhibits of one breed of Terrier or Dog the property of the same Exhibitor (the sexes may be mixed). The competing Dogs must be entered in their respective Classes and also in the Team Class for the breed to which they belong—and the Exhibitor may compete in any number of Teams.

3. An Exhibitor who has previously won one of these "Cruft" Challenge Cups shall not be allowed to compete for it again a second time with the same four Dogs, but must include in his Team at least one or more exhibits which did not compete in any former Team.

4. An Exhibitor winning one of the "Cruft" Challenge Cups for the first time shall be entitled to receive a Gold Medal suitably engraved, and the like should be won it a second time, but should the Exhibitor win it a third time he shall be entitled to receive a Silver Cup value Two Guineas, or a piece of plate of equal value, and a like amount for a fourth win, but should an Exhibitor win it a fifth time he shall be entitled to the said "Cruft" Challenge Cup, value 25 Guineas, and have and retain same.

5. An Exhibitor winning one of these "Cruft" Challenge Cups shall not be entitled to have it in his possession unless he has previously deposited with the said Charles Cruft the sum of Twenty-five Pounds, and should such Exhibitor fail to return the Cup within seven clear days after written application has been made to him at his last address known to Charles Cruft for the said Cup, the amount deposited shall be forfeited, and the Exhibitor shall be held liable for the full value, namely, 25 Guineas, and may not be allowed to compete for any Challenge Cups at any of Charles Cruft's Shows on any future occasions.

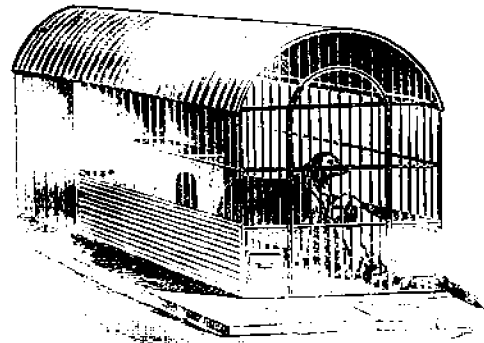
6. The Cup to be returned in the same condition as when handed to a Winner, and should it be damaged the Exhibitor winning same shall be liable, and the amount of damage shall be assessed by the maker, and the said amount deducted from the deposit.

7. The breeders name shall compete together for the Cup as deposited to them, and the Judges shall decide by vote as to the Team entitled to the said Challenge Cup. Should these votes be equal, or any difficulty or unforeseen circumstances arise as to the awarding the said Challenge Cup, it shall be decided by the said Charles Cruft, or by anyone he shall appoint.

8. The above Conditions also apply to the Cup presented by the Proprietor of "ALLY SLOPER'S HALL" HOLIDAY.

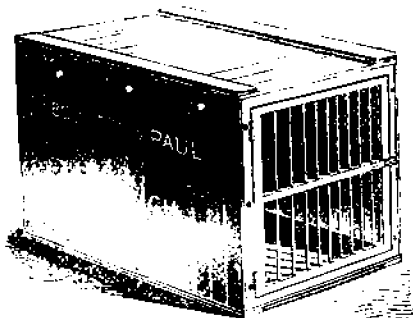

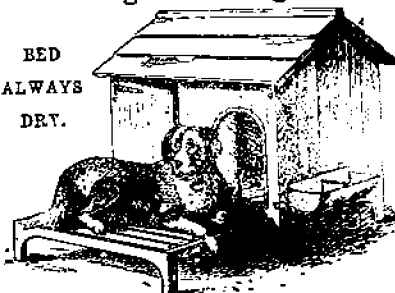

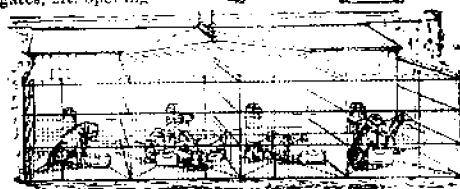

REGULATIONS

FOR
CRUFT'S EIGHTH GREAT DOG SHOW,
February 10th, 11th, and 12th, 1892,
AT THE
AGRICULTURAL HALL, LONDON.

- The Show will be held under the Revised Rules of the Kennel Club.
- Entries.**—Entries should be made on or before Monday, Jan. 11th, 1892, upon Certificates to be issued for that purpose. Post Entries may be received until Monday, Jan. 25th, upon Payment of 5s. each Entry beyond the Entry Fee, and up to Friday, Feb. 5th, upon Payment of double Entry Fees. Exhibitors are particularly requested to note the above Dates. The Prize Lists and Certificates of Entry can be obtained at 325, Holloway Road, London, N., on application.
- Exhibitors forwarding their Entries so as to be received not later than the First Post, Friday, Jan. 8th, and finding they cannot send the Exhibits, will be allowed to cancel any such Entries and receive back the Fees paid for the same, less 2s. 6d. per entry, or to substitute other entries for them without extra payment, at any time up to, but not after the First Post, Feb. 3rd. This Privilege cannot be extended to Exhibitors whose entries are received after the time above mentioned.
- Entry Fees.**—The Entrance Fee for each Dog will be 10s.; but Exhibitors can enter two or more Dogs in the SAME CLASS by paying 5s. each for all entries after the first. The Entrance Fees should be forwarded, with Certificates of Entry, by Jan. 11th. The Entrance Fee for Dogs in Selling Classes is 5s. each. The Entrance Fee in Local Classes is 5s., when the same Dog is entered in OPEN, and 10s. where it is not so entered. Entry Fee to Foreign Exhibitors resident out of Great Britain and Ireland, only half fee will be charged.
- Power to Refuse Entries.**—The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse any entries that they may think fit to exclude.
- Labels.**—Address Labels, with instructions for sending Dogs to the Show, will be forwarded to Exhibitors in due course. Should they not arrive, Dogs should be sent to the Show, and the Secretary advised, as no fees will be returned.
- Arrival of Dogs.**—The Dogs must be at the place of exhibition at 9.30 a.m. on Wednesday morning, February 10th, after which hour the Committee will not undertake to receive Dogs. The keepers will receive Dogs on Tuesday, February 9th. Arrangements have been made with all Railway Companies to deliver the Dogs, as they arrive, to the Royal Agricultural Hall; all charges by rail to be defrayed by Exhibitors. The Dogs will be received at the entrance doors by the officials.
- Food.**—The Dogs will be fed on Spratts Patent Dog Cakes, and attended to free of expense to the Exhibitor during the exhibition.
- Keepers' Passes.**—Special keepers' passes will be provided for *bona fide* keepers only to men who are solely engaged by Exhibitor to attend his dogs. Exhibitors are requested to apply for these passes when making entries, and man's name to be given.
- Sale of Dogs.**—Exhibitors may state in the Certificates the price at which they are prepared to sell their Dogs, and the Sale must take place if an offer be made to purchase at the price fixed. A commission of 10 per cent. will be charged upon all sales, which must be effected through the Sale Office of the Show. If not for sale, that should be stated. Exhibitors may reduce the price of their Dogs upon giving notice to the Secretary, who will furnish them with a card, upon which the reduced price will be marked, at a charge of 1s. No other notice will be allowed to be placed over the Dogs. The commission will be charged on the actual price obtained for the Dog, and should it be found that an Exhibitor has sold any of his Dogs without the Secretary's knowledge, the Committee shall have power to deduct the commission of 10 per cent.
No sale will take place till one hour after each breed has been judged; and if there are two or more applications by that time for the same Dog, the Committee shall at their discretion either have such Dog or Dogs sold by Auction or by Tender, and any surplus thereon shall be equally divided between the Exhibitor and the Committee.
- Power to exclude Dogs.**—The Secretary shall be empowered to exclude any Dog which, in his opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease, vice, or any other cause.

REGULATIONS (continued).

12. Judging.—The judging will take place on Wednesday, February 10th. The Exhibition will continue open on each day of the Show from 10 a.m. until 10 p.m. Exhibitors or their agents can remove their Dogs on presentation of the proper authority as soon as the Show closes. Dogs that are not called for on Friday, February 12th, will be forwarded as early as possible.

13. Judges empowered to withhold Prizes.—The Judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the Prize or Prizes in any class if, in their opinion, the Dog or Dogs exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. In case not more than three Dogs are entered and shown in any class, one Prize only will be awarded, the Judges to determine whether the same shall be a First, Second, or Third Prize.

14. Judges' Decisions.—The decision of the Judges will in all cases be final, except where misrepresentation or breach of the Rules is discovered. Should the Judge be prevented from fulfilling his engagement, the committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other gentlemen to fulfil the duties.

15. Removing Dogs without Leave.—Any person found untying or removing a Dog from its number during the hours the Exhibition is open, without the permission of the Secretary, and refusing to bench same when requested, shall forfeit his Prize or Prizes, and be expelled from the Show. Dogs may be exercised before 9 a.m.

16. Removing Dogs at Night.—Exhibitors will be permitted to take home their Dogs every evening after the Show is closed on leaving a deposit of £1 each Dog, and producing a receipt for the Entrance Fee. This deposit will be forfeited if the Dog is not returned before 10 o'clock every morning the Show is open, and if the winner of a Prize is taken out and not punctually returned the Prize will also be forfeited. Puppies whose age is under 12 months may be removed at the end of the second day of the Show, but at no other time.

17. Exhibitors residing at a distance may remove their Exhibits Last Day at 4 p.m. by paying 5s., and at 7 p.m. by paying 2s. 6d. for each exhibit so removed. The above amount must be paid and the Removal Orders left at the Office for the Secretary's signature, before One o'clock on Feb. 12th. Any Exhibit removed from its bench before the above-named hour will not be allowed to leave before the usual time, and any sum paid under this Regulation will, in that event, be forfeited. Exhibitors are particularly requested not to avail themselves of this Concession unless it is of importance to them to do so.

18. Ownership.—All the Dogs shown must be the property of the Exhibitor in whose name they are entered. Any wilful misrepresentation with regard to the ownership, age, name, pedigree, breeder, or description of a Dog or Dogs will, on being proved to the satisfaction of the Committee, be followed by the exclusion from all future Exhibitions of the person making such false statements. See Kennel Club Rules 1, 2, and 3.

19. Safety of Dogs.—The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the Dogs sent for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them; but it must be distinctly understood by Exhibitors and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any Dogs or other property, whether arising from accident or other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants, or others.

20. Admission.—Admission to the Dog Show to Non-Exhibitors:—Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., 2s. 6d.; 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., 6d. Thursday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., 6d. Friday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., 6d. Tickets can be purchased at these prices prior to the Show.

21. Exhibitors' Free Passes.—Exhibitors will receive a free pass, not transferable, available on any day of the Exhibition. This pass will be forwarded with the labels for the Dogs; it will admit the Exhibitor to the Exhibition any time the Show is open to the Public. It is not transferable. A ticket must be obtained for re-admission, which must be shown together with the Exhibitor's Pass.

22. Power to Cancel Classes.—The Committee reserve to themselves the right to cancel any Class or Classes, should they think fit, and in such case the amount of Entry Fee in that Class will be returned.

KENNEL CLUB RULES.

REVISED 1891

1. Every dog exhibited at a show under the Kennel Club Rules must, except only those entered in local classes, previous to the time of entry for such show, be entered in a registry of names kept by the Kennel Club at their offices, 6, Cleveland Row, St. James's, London, S.W. A charge of 1s. each dog will be made for registration. A name that has been already assumed and duly registered in the Kennel Club registry, or entered in any published number of the *Kennel Club Calendar* or *Stud Book*, by the owner of a dog of the same breed, cannot be registered except by a distinguishing name or number. If the name of a dog be changed, or an old name be reassumed, such name shall be required to be registered previous to the time of entry.

2. Dogs that are already entered in any published number of the *Kennel Club Calendar* and *Stud Book* are exempt from the above rule, provided their names remain unchanged. Puppies exhibited in classes exclusively for litters of puppies are also exempt.

3. Any dog which is to be exhibited at a show held under Kennel Club Rules must be the *bona fide* property of the exhibitor in whose name he is entered, and must have been 14 clear days before the first day of the show. Each dog must, on the entry form, be clearly identified by name, by date of birth, and by the names of his sire and dam, and of the breeder, each and every of them, if known (as registered in accordance with Rule 1), and if the dam was covered by more than one dog the names of all must be given. If the age, pedigree, or breeder's name be not known, the dog must be entered at each show as breeder, age, or pedigree unknown, any or all, as the case may be.

4. The *bona fide* owner of the dam at the time she whelps shall be considered to be the breeder of the litter. In cases where a bitch is lent for breeding purposes, the person to whom the bitch is lent shall be considered the breeder of all puppies born during the period of such loan, provided he or she, before the litter is born, send to the Secretary of the Kennel Club a statement of the facts, signed by himself or herself and the owner of the bitch.

5. If the name of a dog which has won a prize in any class at any show held under Kennel Club Rules has been changed, it is necessary in entering the said dog to give his old name as well as his new name every time he is exhibited, until the change has been duly published in the annual number of the *Kennel Club Calendar* and *Stud Book*; and if his name be changed again, all his names must be repeated for a like period.

6. If a dog shall be entered except as before directed by Rules 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, he shall forfeit any prize that may have been awarded him; and if the omission be detected in time, he shall not be allowed to compete, and shall in either case forfeit all entrance fees and subscriptions.

7. The committee or authorities of any show may reserve to themselves the right of refusing any entries they may think fit to exclude.

8. A castrated dog or spayed bitch shall be disqualified from competing, or from receiving a prize if awarded.

9. Total blindness shall absolutely disqualify; partial blindness shall have great weight against a dog. Should a dog appear to be deaf or lame, it shall be in the power of the judge to disqualify unless he is satisfied that such defects are temporary.

10. No dog shall be qualified to compete who shall be declared by the duly qualified and appointed veterinary inspector during the show to exhibit any form of contagious or infectious disease, neither shall such dog be entitled, if in that condition, to receive a prize awarded unless the committee shall consider that the owner of the dog was not to blame in the matter. The veterinary inspector shall give his decision in writing, duly signed, to the secretary or committee of the show before its close, and such opinion shall be final as regards the condition of the dog.

11. If any prize-winner is disqualified, the next dog in order of merit as placed by the judge shall take his position, and the win shall count in every respect the same as if it had been the original award. An equal (challenge), or first prize shall be counted as a win to both dogs.

12. Any person who is proved to the satisfaction of the committee of the Kennel Club to have been guilty of any fraudulent or discreditable conduct in connection with dogs, dog shows, or field trials, may, in addition to any pecuniary penalty to which he may be liable, be declared incapable of competing for or winning a prize at any show or field trials held under the Kennel Club Rules for such period as the committee of the Kennel Club may decide upon.

13. In estimating the number of prizes a dog has won, the number of prizes won shall be calculated up to 12 p.m. of the day previous to the original day of closing entries for the show.

14. A dog that has been exhibited or has won a prize in a class exclusively for puppies under twelve months old on the first day of the show, is not thereby excluded from being exhibited in a class where previous prize winners are not allowed to compete.

15. The Committee of the Kennel Club shall publish as early as possible in each year in *The Kennel Gazette* a list of shows selected by them as being worthy to rank as two-point shows. A first prize at any one of such shows shall for purposes of a challenge class qualification count two points. A first prize at any other show under Kennel Club Rules shall count one point. No dog shall be

qualified to compete in a challenge class that has won less than ten points at shows registered in or for *The Kennel Club Calendar* and *Stud Book*; and no dog shall compete in an open class that is qualified to compete in a challenge class at any show where challenge classes are provided for that breed. The prizes must be won in open classes which are open to all dogs of any breed without restriction, or in varieties of the same breed divided by weight, colour, sex or age in adult classes.

16. No dog shall in future be entitled to be called a champion that has not scored six points in challenge classes, two of which must be at the Kennel Club Shows, at the shows of the National Dog Show Society, Birmingham, Scottish Kennel Club, Edinburgh, or such shows held by specialist clubs as the committee of the Kennel Club may determine. Each win in a challenge class at a two-point show (as explained in Rule 15) shall count two points, and each win in a challenge class at other shows under Kennel Club Rules one point.

N.B. to Rules 15 to 16: These rules shall come into operation upon January 1st, 1889, and any dog which shall have qualified previously to that date for competition in a champion class or challenge class must compete in a challenge class where such class is provided. Any dog entitled to be called a champion before that date shall not be deprived of his title.

17. If any dog be disqualified by the judge, or formally objected to during the show for being improperly tampered with, the veterinary inspector shall examine the dog, and give his opinion to the secretary in writing before the close of the show.

18. An objection to a dog may be made by any person; it must be made to the secretary of the show at any time within fourteen days from the last day of the show. The objection must be in writing, and the objector must, unless in cases where the objection is laid by the Committee of the Kennel Club, or by the regularly constituted committee of the show (in which case a deposit shall not be necessary), at the same time lodge a sum of £1 in the hands of the secretary, which deposit shall, if the objection be proved to be frivolous to the satisfaction of the Committee of the Kennel Club, be forfeited. Such objection must be brought by the secretary before his committee, if possible, within fourteen days of the objection being lodged; and any persons concerned shall have due notice from the secretary of the show of the meeting, and an opportunity of making any statement which they may desire relevant to the case. The said committee shall decide the case, but under any circumstances an appeal shall lie to the committee of the Kennel Club.

19. The term "foreign dog" (for exhibition purposes) shall not include any dog for which a separate class is provided in the Kennel Club Register of Names or in the schedule.

20. All dogs entered for competition and actually in the show, are in the power of the committee of such show, and may not be withdrawn from competition without the sanction of the committee or secretary.

21. In the above rules the word "dog" shall be interpreted to include both sexes.

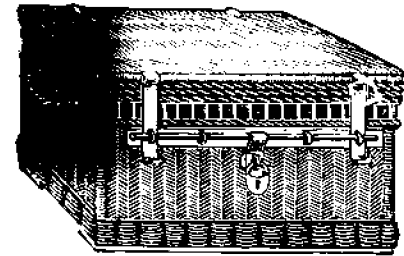

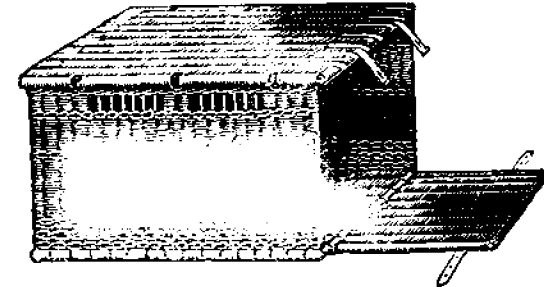

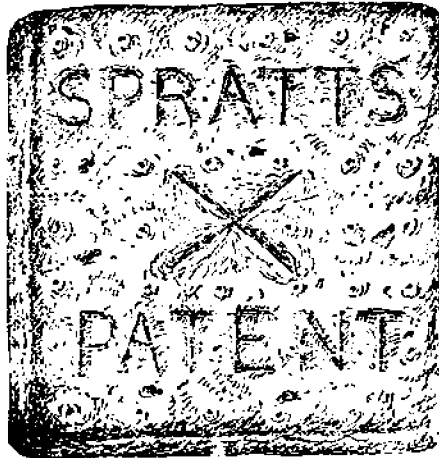
