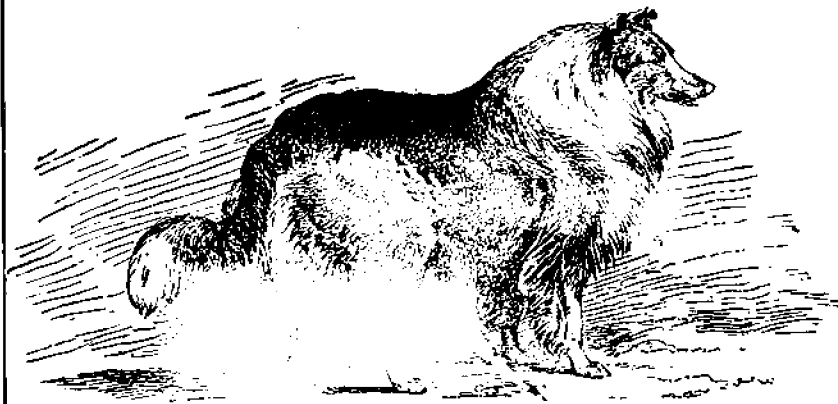

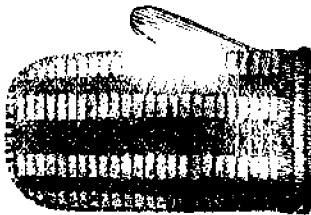

FOR

CRUFT'S THIRTEENTH GREAT DOG SHOW,

February 10th, 11th and 12th, 1897,

AT THE

AGRICULTURAL HALL, LONDON.

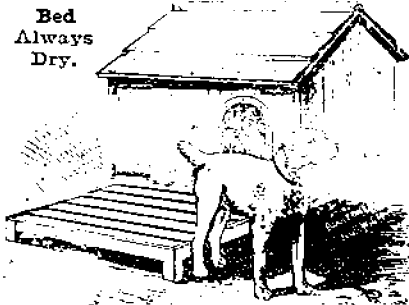
1. The Show will be held under the Revised Rules of the Kennel Club.
2. **Entries.**—All entries should be made on or before **Monday, Jan. 25th, 1897**, upon Certificates to be issued for that purpose. The Prize Lists and Certificates of Entry can be obtained at the Royal Agricultural Hall, and 325, Holloway Road, London, N., on application.
3. Exhibitors forwarding their Entries so as to be received not later than the first post, **Friday, Jan. 22nd**, and finding they cannot send the Exhibits, will be allowed to cancel any such Entries and receive back the Fees paid for the same, less 2s. 6d. per entry, or to substitute other Entries for them without extra payment, at any time up to, but not after, the first post, **Feb. 1st**. This privilege cannot be extended to Exhibitors whose Entries are received after the time above-mentioned.
4. **Entry Fees**—The Entrance Fee for each Class will be 10s.; but Exhibitors can enter two or more Dogs in the SAME CLASS by paying 5s. each for all Entries after the first. The Entrance Fees should be forwarded, with Certificates of Entry, by **Jan. 25th**. The Entrance Fee for Dogs in Selling or Auction Classes is 5s. each. The Fee for Dogs put up to Auction is 5s. Dogs not for competition, 5s. each.
5. **Power to Refuse Entries.**—The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse any Entries that they may think fit to exclude.
6. **Power to exclude Dogs.**—The Committee will be empowered to exclude or remove any Dog which, in their opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease, vice, or any other cause.
7. **Labels.**—Address Labels, with instructions for sending Dogs to the Show, will be forwarded to Exhibitors in due course. Should they not arrive, Dogs should be sent to the Show and the Secretary advised, as no fees will be returned.
8. **Safety of Dogs.**—The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the Dogs sent for Exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them; but it must be distinctly understood by Exhibitors and all other persons, that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any Dogs or other property, whether arising from accident or other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants, or others.
9. **Chains.**—All Dogs must be forwarded with a strong chain and suitable plain leather collar. There must be two spring hooks three swivels, and two rings to each chain, to which must be attached (six inches from collar) the metal tally.
10. **Admissions.**—The Show will be open to all Exhibitors, whether they are Subscribers or not, and they may compete for the Class Prizes; but the competition for the Challenge Trophies and other Special Prizes shall be confined to Subscribers to Cruft's International Dog Show, except where otherwise stated. **SUBSCRIPTION** :—Annual Subscription, £1 1s. Admission to the Dog Show to Non-Exhibitors :—Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., 2s. 6d.; 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., 6d.; Thursday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., 6d.; Friday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., 1s.; after 6 p.m., 6d. Tickets can be purchased at these prices prior to the Show.
11. **Exhibitors' Free Passes.**—Exhibitors will receive a free pass, available on any day of the Exhibition. This pass will be forwarded with the labels for the Dogs; it will admit the Exhibitor or his agent to the Exhibition any time the Show is open to the Public. A ticket must be obtained for re-admission, which must be shown together with the Exhibitor's Pass.
12. **Keepers' Passes.**—Special keepers' passes can be had at a charge of 2s. 6d. each for *bona fide* keepers only to men who are solely engaged by Exhibitor to attend his dogs. Exhibitors are requested to apply for these passes when making entries, and man's name to be given.
13. **Power to Cancel Classes.**—The Committee reserve to themselves the right to cancel any Class or Classes should they think fit, and in such case the amount of Entry Fee in that Class only will be returned.
14. **Weighing.**—In Classes where there is a fixed limit, Owners may claim to have their Dogs weighed on entering the Show, which weight will be registered; if not so registered, they can be weighed at any time at the discretion of the Committee or Secretary.

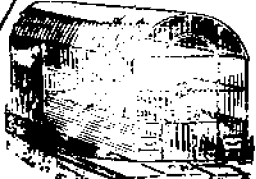

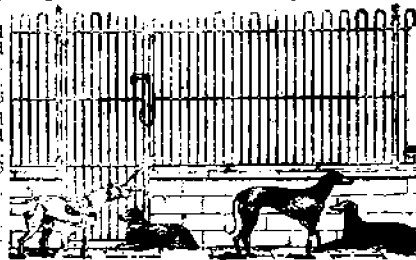

15. **Food.**—The Dogs will be fed and attended to free of expense to the Exhibitor during the Exhibition.

16. **Arrival of Dogs.**—The Dogs must be at the place of exhibition at 9.30 a.m. on Wednesday morning, Feb. 10th, after which hour the Committee will not undertake to receive Dogs. The keepers will receive Dogs on Tuesday, Feb. 9th. Arrangements have been made with all Railway Companies to deliver the Dogs, as they arrive, to the Royal Agricultural Hall; all charges by rail to be defrayed by Exhibitors. The Dogs will be received at the entrance doors by the officials.

17. **Judging.**—The judging will take place on Wednesday, February 10th and following day. The Exhibition will continue open on each day of the Show from 10 a.m. until 10 p.m.

18. **Judges' Decisions.**—The decision of the Judges will in all cases be final, except where misrepresentation or breach of the Rules is discovered. Should any Judge be prevented from fulfilling his engagement, the Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other gentlemen to fulfil the duties.

19. **Judges empowered to withhold Prizes.**—The Judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the Prize or Prizes in any class if, in their opinion, the Dog or Dogs exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. In case not more than three Dogs are entered and shown in any class, one Prize only will be awarded, the Judges to determine whether the same shall be a First, Second, or Third Prize.

20. Judges are not empowered to give Prizes beyond those offered in this Schedule of Prizes. Any such award shall not have any value, or count as a win, except the consent of the Secretary be first obtained in writing.

21. **Special Prizes.**—Exhibitors must state at time of entry, on the entry forms supplied for entering Dogs, the number of any Specials their Dogs are eligible to compete for; otherwise the Committee will not be responsible if they do not compete for Specials.

22. No Team or Brace can compete, or win a Special given for Brace or Team unless entered in Brace or Team Class, neither can a Special Prize offered for best Puppy, Novice, Stud Dog, or Breeders' Competition be won or competed for unless the winner is entered in the respective Class.

23. **Sale of Dogs.**—Exhibitors may state in the Certificates the price at which they are prepared to sell their Dogs, and the Sale must take place if an offer be made to purchase at the price fixed. A commission of 10 per cent. will be charged upon all sales, which must be effected through the Sale Office of the Show. If not for sale, that should be stated. Exhibitors may reduce the price of their Dogs upon giving notice to the Secretary, who will furnish them with a card, upon which the reduced price will be marked, at a charge of 1s. No other notice will be allowed to be placed over the Dogs. The commission will be charged on the actual price obtained for the Dog; and should it be found that an Exhibitor has sold any of his Dogs without the Secretary's knowledge, the Committee shall have power to deduct the commission of 10 per cent.

24. No sale will take place until after 4 p.m. on the first day of the Show, and if there are two or more applications by that time for the same Dog, the Committee shall at their discretion have such Dog or Dogs sold either by Auction or by Tender, and any surplus thereon shall be equally divided between the Exhibitor and the Committee.

25. **Removing Dogs without Leave.**—Any person found untying or removing a Dog from its number during the hours the Exhibition is open, without the permission of the Secretary, and refusing to bench same when requested, shall forfeit his Prize or Prizes and may be expelled from the Show. Dogs may be exercised in the appointed places before 10 a.m. or between 5.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m., and at no other time.

26. **Removing Dogs at Night.**—Exhibitors will be permitted to take home their Dogs every evening after the Show is closed on leaving a deposit of £1 each Dog and producing a receipt for the Entrance Fee. This deposit will be forfeited if the Dog is not returned before 10 o'clock every morning the Show is open, and if the winner of a Prize is taken out and not punctually returned, the Prize will also be forfeited.

27. Exhibitors may remove their Exhibits Second or Last Day at 4 p.m. by paying 5s. and at 7 p.m. by paying 2s. 6d. for each Exhibit so removed. The above amount must be paid and the early Pass obtained at the Secretary's office. Any Exhibit removed from its bench before the above-named hour will not be allowed to leave before the usual time, and any sum paid under this Regulation will, in that event, be forfeited. Exhibitors are particularly requested not to avail themselves of this concession unless it is of importance to them to do so.

28. **Ownership.**—All the Dogs shown must be the property of the Exhibitor in whose name they are entered. Any wilful misrepresentation with regard to the ownership, age, name, pedigree, breeder, or description of a Dog or Dogs will, on being proved to the satisfaction of the Committee, be followed by the exclusion from all future Exhibitions of the person making such false statements. See Kennel Club Rules.

29. **Despatch of Dogs.**—Should Exhibitors desire to have their Dogs despatched on Friday night they should send their removal orders duly signed to the Railway Company's officials in London, instructing them to collect and forward, at the same time stating if on chain, in box, or hamper. The Show officials cannot undertake to despatch dogs other than those for Scotland, Ireland or Continent on Friday night. Exhibitors or their agents can remove their Dogs on presentation of the proper authority as soon as the Show closes. Puppies whose age is under 12 months may be removed at the end of the second day of the Show, but at no other time.

- 30. Dogs not called for Friday night will be despatched as early as possible on Saturday.
 - 31. All Rules, Regulations, definitions or instructions of the nature of Rules or Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be Regulations of Cruft's International Dog Show, and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of the Regulations.
 - 32. Should any question arise not provided for by these Regulations or by the Kennel Club Rules, the decision of the Committee thereon shall be final, subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.
 - 33. An announcement in the "Stock Keeper" or "Our Dogs" of any alteration or addition made by the Committee in this Schedule, or in these Regulations, shall be deemed full and sufficient notice thereof.
 - 34. Every Exhibitor making an entry or entries at or for this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules printed herein, and by the Regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
 - 35. Correspondence.—All correspondence, inquiries, Entry Fees, and Subscriptions will be received by CHARLES CRUFT, 325, Holloway Road, London, N., and at Royal Agricultural Hall, London, N. Correspondents requiring replies by telegram must prepay same.
- A Handsome Illustrated PRIZE CARD will be given to each Winner of a Prize, and should be applied for during the Show, or sent on receipt of two penny stamps.
- Anyone requiring a Catalogue should send 1s. 3d. in Stamps or Postal Order to the Secretary.

Conditions for the "JAEGER" CHALLENGE CUP (Value 60 guineas).

- 1. This Cup will be offered annually by Dr. Jaeger's Sanitary Woollen System Company, Limited, at Cruft's Great Dog Shows, for the best-conditioned Brace of Dogs (irrespective of sex) of any one breed, being the long life property of the Exhibitor, who must be a subscriber to Cruft's Show.
- 2. They must be entered in their respective Classes, and in the Brace Class of the breed to which they belong. The same Exhibitor may compete with any number of Braces.
- 3. All Competitors must show their Dogs together at the time appointed for adjudication, when the Judges will make their award by vote. Should the votes be equal, or any difficulty arise in making the award, it shall be decided by Mr. Charles Cruft, or anyone whom he may appoint.
- 4. The Exhibitor winning the "Jaeger Challenge Cup" will be presented with a Champion Dog Coat, Badge, other souvenir of success.
- 5. A successful Exhibitor will not be eligible to compete again with the same Brace of Dogs.
- 6. The winner of the "Jaeger Challenge Cup" will be entitled to its custody upon depositing 60 guineas, and undertaking to return it within one month after written application has been made to him at his last address known to Mr. Charles Cruft. If he fails to return it he will be held responsible for 60 guineas, or his deposit will be forfeited.
- 7. The Cup must be returned in the same condition as when handed to the winner. Should it be damaged or require burnishing, &c., the amount charged by the makers for putting it in order shall be deducted from the deposit.

Conditions for the Competition of the "CRUFT" CHALLENGE BOWLS.

- 1. To be competed for only at Shows where the class divisions in every breed mentioned as competitive are supported by the Committee of Cruft's Show with Special Prizes.
- 2. To be won three times by an Exhibitor before becoming his or her property.
- 3. No Dog having won once to be eligible to compete again unless the ownership has been changed.
- 4. Three Judges to award the Prizes, to be appointed by the Committee of Cruft's Show.
- 5. No Dog under 12 months to be eligible for competition.
- 6. At Shows where the Classes are open to all Exhibitors, no Dog not having won a First, Second or Third Prize in its Class on the day of competition to be eligible to compete for these prizes.
- 7. The Committee will give a Prize Medal to each winner at each Show where the Challenge Bowls are in competition.

Conditions for the Competition of the "CRUFT" CHALLENGE TEAM CUPS.

- 1. The competition for these Cups shall be confined to the various breeds of Terriers and Dogs, and shall be offered for competition less than once in each year, and be confined to the subscribers to Cruft's Dog Shows.
- 2. Each Cup will be offered for the best Team of three or more exhibits of one breed of Terrier or Dog the property of the same Exhibitor (the sexes may be mixed). The competing Dogs must be entered in their respective Classes and also in the Team Class for the breed to which they belong—and the Exhibitor may compete with any number of Teams.
- 3. An Exhibitor who has previously won one of these "Cruft" Challenge Cups shall not be allowed to compete for it again a second time with the same Dogs, but must include in his Team at least one or more exhibits which did not compete in any former Team.
- 4. An Exhibitor winning one of the "Cruft" Challenge Cups for the first time shall be entitled to receive a Medal suitably engraved, and the like should he win it a second time, but should the Exhibitor win it a third time he shall be entitled to receive a Silver Cup value Two Guineas, or a piece of plate of equal value, and the like for a fourth win, but should an Exhibitor win it a fifth time he shall be entitled to the said "Cruft" Challenge Cup, value 25 Guineas, and have and retain same.
- 5. An Exhibitor winning one of these "Cruft" Challenge Cups prior to the fifth win shall not be entitled to have it in his possession unless he has previously deposited with the said Charles Cruft the sum of Twenty-five Pounds, and should such Exhibitor fail to return the Cup within seven clear days after written application has been made to him at his last address known to Charles Cruft for the said Cup, the amount deposited shall be forfeited and the Exhibitor shall be held liable for the full value, namely, 25 Guineas, and may not be allowed to compete for any Challenge Cups at any of Charles Cruft's Shows on any future occasions.

3. That the Warwick Vase be offered for the best Collie, bred by exhibitor. The Committee will give a Prize Medal to each winner at each show where the Vase is offered for competition.

Rules for L.K.A. Specials.—1. All Dogs in Limit, Novice, or Puppy Classes, having won V.H.C. only in their Class, are debarred from competing for Specials.

2. All Dogs in Open or Winners' Class, though having won a V.H.C. only in their Class shall be allowed to compete, provided they are not eligible to compete in Limit Class by reason of having won more 1st prizes than the Limit allows. 3. No lady can compete for these Specials unless she is a member of the L.K.A.

Stud Dog Classes. Points will be awarded as in the Breeders' Competition (see above), but in the absence of the Stud Dog the prize will not be awarded. The Prize in these Classes will be a Medal.

KENNEL CLUB RULES.

REVISED MARCH 4th, 1895.

In the following Rules the word *Dog* shall be interpreted to include both sexes.

1.—Every dog exhibited at a show under the Kennel Club Rules must (except such as are exhibited exclusively in Local Classes, or exhibited in classes exclusively for litters of puppies), previous to the time of entry for such show, have been entered in a registry kept by the Kennel Club at their offices. A charge of 1s. each dog shall be made for registration. In such registry shall be inserted the name and breed of the dog, and its breeder's name, the date of birth, names of sire and dam, and of grand-sires and grand-dams, and if the dam was served by two or more dogs, their several names must be stated. If the age, pedigree, or breeder's name be not known, the dog must be registered as breeder, age or pedigree "*unknown*," any or all as the case may be. If the name of a dog be changed, or an old name be re-assumed, such dog must be again registered and identified before exhibition in its altered name. On change of ownership the transfer of a dog must be registered, and no dog shall be eligible for exhibition at any show or field trials held under Kennel Club Rules until such registration shall have been made, for which a fee of 1s. will be charged.

2.—The name selected for any dog must have as part of its name for Exhibition purposes the last two numerals of the year of its birth added as an affix, or, if the year of its birth is unknown, then the last two numerals of the year in which the dog is registered with the letter K before them, but such numerals to be in no way considered as a distinguishing affix. First, second, &c., will not be accepted either in words or Roman numerals as a distinguishing prefix or affix, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse any name they may see fit. A name which has been duly registered in accordance with Rule 1 cannot be again accepted for registration of a dog of the same breed without the addition of a distinguishing prefix or affix, for a period of five years, calculated from the first day of the year next after the one in which the name was last registered; but the name of a dog after publication in the *Kennel Club Calendar and Stud Book*, or which has become eligible for entry therein, cannot again be assumed.

3.—Any dog exhibited at a show under the Kennel Club Rules must be the *bona fide* property of the exhibitor in whose name it is entered, and must have so been fourteen clear days before the first day of the show. Each dog must on the entry form be clearly identified in accordance with and as required in Rules 1 and 2—save that the names of the grandparents need not be stated—and on such entry form must be a declaration, signed by the exhibitor, that the dog is entered subject to the Rules of the Kennel Club.

4.—The *bona fide* owner of the dam at the time she whelps shall be considered to be the breeder of the litter. In cases, however, when the bitch is lent for breeding purposes, the person to whom the bitch is lent shall be considered the breeder of all puppies born during the period of such loan, provided he or she, before the litter be born, send to the Secretary of the Kennel Club a statement of the facts signed by himself or herself and the owner of the bitch.

5.—If the name of a dog which has won a prize in a class in any show held under the Kennel Club Rules has been changed, on entering the said dog for a show the exhibitor must on the entry form give the former name or names as well as the new name until the change or changes have been duly published in the *Kennel Club Calendar and Stud Book*. The name of any dog that has become eligible for entry in the *Kennel Club Calendar and Stud Book* in any year, shall not be changed after the 31st of December of that year.

6.—If a dog be entered, except as before directed by Rules 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, such dog shall forfeit any prize that may have been awarded, and if the error be detected in time, such dog shall not be allowed to compete, and shall in either case forfeit all entrance fees and subscriptions, save that the Committee of the Kennel Club may, on appeal to them, for good cause shown, remit all or any part of the forfeit herein mentioned.

7.—The term "*foreign dog*" (for exhibition purposes) shall not include any breed for which a separate class is made in the Kennel Club index of names.

8.—The Committee of any show may reserve to themselves the right of refusing any entries they may think fit to exclude.

9.—A dog which is totally blind or totally deaf, a castrated dog or spayed bitch, or one which has in any way been improperly tampered with, shall be disqualified from competition or from receiving a prize if awarded.

10.—At any show held under Kennel Club Rules a duly qualified veterinary surgeon must be appointed by the Committee of such show as veterinary inspector, whose duty it shall be to examine each dog before it is benched, and no dog shall be qualified to compete, when on arrival at, or during the show, exhibits any form of contagious or infectious disease; neither shall such dog be entitled to receive any prize, if awarded, unless the Committee of the Kennel Club shall consider that the owner has been free from all blame in the matter. The veterinary inspector shall give his decision in writing, duly signed, to the Secretary of the show before its close, and such opinion shall be final as regards the condition of the dog.

11.—If any dog be formally objected to during the show for being improperly tampered with, or for blindness or deafness, or for exhibiting any form of contagious or infectious disease, the veterinary inspector shall examine the dog and give his opinion to the Secretary of the show in writing before the close of the show.

12.—Any person who is proved to the satisfaction of the Committee of the Kennel Club to have been guilty of fraudulent or discreditable conduct in regard to Dogs, Dog Shows, or Field Trials, shall, in addition to any pecuniary penalty to which he may be liable, be suspended from judging, competing, winning a prize, or taking any part at a show or field trials held under the Kennel Club Rules for such period as the Committee of the Kennel Club may determine. Furthermore, the committee of a show or field trial meeting, shall not, during that period, employ such person in any capacity, or such act may disqualify the show or field trial meeting from the future use of the Kennel Club Rules; and should such person work a dog at a field trial meeting, or lead one in the judging ring at any show, the dog so worked or led shall be liable to be disqualified from receiving a prize, if awarded.

13.—In estimating the number of prizes a dog has won, such shall be calculated up to midnight previous to the original day of closing entries for the show, as advertised in the schedule.

14.—A dog that has been exhibited or has won a prize in a class exclusively for puppies under twelve months old on the first day of the show, or a prize winner in a competition not open to all exhibitors, is not thereby excluded from being exhibited in a class where previous prize winners are not allowed to compete.

15.—The Committee of a show may make any classification they think desirable; prizes won in such classes as the Committee of the Kennel Club may determine will be recorded in the *Kennel Club Calendar and Stud Book*.

16.—Any class may be divided or limited by variety, weight, colour, height or sex.

17.—The Committee of the Kennel Club shall select and publish in the *Kennel Gazette* a list of shows, which shall be called Championship Shows. The Committee of the selected shows shall provide in such breed, or varieties of a breed as the Committee of the Kennel Club may determine, championship prizes, which prizes shall be awarded, without any extra entry fee, to the best dog of its breed or variety in the show, in addition to any other prize or prizes the dog may have won at the show when competing in its right class. A dog having won three of the above-mentioned championship prizes shall have the title of "Champion."

18.—At Championship Shows the classification must be such as to allow any dog of those breeds or varieties of a breed in which championship prizes are to be awarded, to compete in at least one class. But no championship prize or certificate shall be awarded to any dog unless such dog has won a 1st or 2nd prize in the class competition.

19.—An objection to a dog may be made by any person, but it must be made to the Secretary of the show within twenty-one days from the last day of the show. The objection must be in writing, and the objector must, except in cases when the objection is laid by the Committee of the Kennel Club, or by the regularly constituted Committee of the show (in which case a deposit shall not be necessary), at the same time lodge a sum of £1 in the hands of the Secretary, which deposit shall, if the objection be proved frivolous to the satisfaction of the Committee of the Kennel Club, be forfeited. Such objection must be brought by the Secretary before his Committee, if possible, within fourteen days of the objection being lodged; and any persons concerned shall have due notice of the meeting, together with a copy of the objection to the registered owner, from the Secretary of the show, and an opportunity of making any statement relevant to the case. The said Committee shall decide the case, but under any circumstances an appeal shall lie to the Committee of the Kennel Club, if lodged within fourteen days from the date of the decision.

20.—If any prize-winner be disqualified the dog or dogs next in consecutive order of merit, if so placed by the judge, shall take the higher positions in the prize-list, provided it or they have been awarded not less than "Very Highly Commended," and the win or wins shall count in every respect as if they had been the original awards. An equal first prize shall be counted as a win to both dogs.

21.—Any dog entered for competition, and actually in the show, may not be withdrawn from competition without the consent of the Committee or Secretary; but in the event of a judge advertised in the schedule not officiating, it shall be optional to the exhibitor, before commencement of judging the breed, to withdraw his dog or dogs from competition.

22.—No dog born after 31st March, 1895, nor Irish Terrier born after the 31st December, 1889, can, if cropped, win a prize at any show held under Kennel Club Rules.

23.—The Committee of the Kennel Club may register under such regulations as they may consider desirable, assumed names to be used by exhibitors for purposes of exhibition.

24.—The word "Committee" in these Rules shall be construed to mean the majority of the members of a Committee attending a duly-called meeting of such Committee and voting on the question in dispute, and in the event of the votes of such Members so voting being equally divided, then the word "Committee" shall be construed as meaning the Chairman of such Committee meeting, who shall have the casting vote.

25.—The Committee of the Kennel Club shall be the final Court of Appeal or Umpire in all questions or disputes of any kind soever, arising from the computing of any dog at any shows or field trials held under the Kennel Club Rules, and whether such dispute be between two or more exhibitors, or between exhibitor and exhibitors and the Committee or Secretary, Veterinary Inspector or Judge or Judges of such show, or between any one or more of such parties and another or others of them and any person or persons acting in any of the capacities above mentioned at any show held under the Kennel Club Rules, shall be deemed thereby to agree to refer any dispute which may arise between them or any of them to the Committee of the Kennel Club, and such reference shall in all cases be deemed a reference under the Arbitration Act, 1889, or any statutory modification thereof.

26.—A certificate in writing, recording the decision of the Committee, signed by the Secretary of the Kennel Club for the time being, shall be conclusive evidence of the fact of such committee meeting having been duly called, and that the decision therein mentioned was the due and proper finding and award of such Committee, and the production of the last-published number of the *Kennel Gazette*, in which the name of the Secretary is mentioned as Secretary shall be deemed conclusive evidence that the person therein named is the duly appointed Secretary of the Kennel Club for the time being.
