

Kennel Club International Agility Festival Report

- The International Agility Festival in 2017 will be held from 10-13 August 2017 at Rockingham Castle. This venue has been secured for 2017, 2018 and 2019
- The Kennel Club would like to thank the International Agility Festival's principle sponsor, CSJ Specialist Canine Feeds, for its continued support.
- The Kennel Club is pleased to announce that all the Olympia Quarter-Finals and Semi-Finals will be held again at the International Agility Festival.
- Plans for 2017 have started happening. Jonathan Hallam is creating a new version of the site map, as we are adding an extra 2 rings (will definitely be using one of the extra rings)
- "First Contact" is the equipment suppliers for all rings
- Will be securing the cadets again next year. This has been very useful for when rings have not had as many helpers as expected
- Contractors have been contacted to provide quotes. Due to generator issues, we will be finding a new supplier for next year
- Camping will be limited to 750 units, including judges and officials. This year we are allocating scribe camping spaces to judges. We will be asking everyone to book their camping on iSS to help stop duplication of lists. Barrie Harvey will be asked to allocate camping spaces again for us. Marie Douglas and Judith Trickett will be asked to manage the booking in team as this worked very well last year.
- Invitations to judges will be sent out in November
- Two International judges have been confirmed, and have had permission to judge: Bernd Hueppe from Austria, and Jourden Maryannic from France.
- Trade Stand cost is being increased by 5%. The number of trade stand pitches will remain the same.
