Kennel Club Working Trials Regulations I(D) paragraph 7 – Minimum judging experience required for the Senior Stake at Championship Bloodhound Trials.

On a person’s first appointment to judge a Senior Stake at a Championship Bloodhound Trial, the minimum conditions which apply are:

- Must have judged at least three stakes, not at the same trial, before being allowed to award a Kennel Club Bloodhound Working Trial Certificate.
- Must have been assessed by a Kennel Club approved assessor.
- Must have attended a Kennel Club Bloodhound, Regulations and Judging Procedure Seminar and passed the Regulations and Judging Procedure examination.

A person may be approved to judge one Senior Stake in each calendar year commencing 1st January.

Documentary evidence of previous judging may be required and must be provided if called upon.
