

International Agility Festival 2017 Report

- The arrangements for the International Agility Festival to be held at Rockingham Castle from 10-13 August 2017 are progressing well. Rockingham Castle has provisionally been booked as the venue for the International Agility Festival for 2018, 2019 and 2020
- The Festival is continuing to be a four day event with qualifiers for Crufts, Discover Dogs and Kennel Club Nations Cup. The festival is also hosting again Kennel Club Olympia Quarter and Semi-Finals
- Trade stand spaces are full with 53 traders. This is a mix of recurring trade stands, as well as a good number of new trade stands
- This year we have used ASO instead of iSS for online entries and camping. Camping is now full and we have a waiting list of 300 people. We hope to release another 50 spaces closer to the entry deadline
- In previous years we have had about 25 countries attend. Due to the Border Collie Classics (BCC) being held before IAF, we are expecting more countries to attend, as well as an increase in international entries
- “First Contact” is the main agility equipment supplier and will be supplying rubber chip contacts in all rings.
