Regulation E1. Welfare of Dogs

TO:

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. **The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Canicross event licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the competition.**

Regulation E(A)2.b

TO:

No dog may be entered in more than ~~one~~ **three** races per day, the total distance of which must not exceed 10km per day.

TO:

Competitors must be aged at least ~~8~~ **6** years on the day of the competition to take part in a canicross race.

TO:

Competitors ~~below~~ **between 8 and** 14 years of age on the day of the competition are not eligible to enter races of more than 5km in length. ~~and must be accompanied throughout the race by a responsible adult (who may run or use a bicycle).~~

Competitors under 8 years of age on the day of the competition are not eligible to enter races of more than 3km in length and must be accompanied throughout the race by a responsible adult (who may run or use a bicycle).
