CLAIM FOR A JUNIOR WARRANT

Junior Warrant points cannot be claimed from classes or for awards with less than three dogs of the breed present. In assessing the number of dogs present in each class, exhibitors may count a dog as having been present in a class provided it was entered in that class and was present in its first class for the breed at the Show.

A Junior Warrant will be issued on receipt of an application from the registered owner at the time of qualification, We cannot accept claims after 6 months of the last qualifying show in respect of a dog that has obtained 25 points between the ages of 6 and 18 months. A minimum of three points must be won at Championship Shows where Challenge Certificates for the breed are on offer and a minimum of 3 points won at Open Shows or Championship Shows where Challenge Certificates are not offered for the breed. The scale of points is as follows:

- 1 Three points for each First Prize awarded in a Breed Class at a Championship Show where Challenge Certificates were on offer for the breed.
- 2 One point for each First Prize awarded in a Breed Class at a Championship Show where Challenge Certificates were not offered for the breed, or at an Open Show.
- 3 Three points for the award of Best of Breed at a Championship show where Challenge Certificates were on offer for the breed if no Junior Warrant points were gained by that dog by winning a Breed Class or Classes at that show.
- 4 One Point for the award of Best of Breed at an Open Show or at a Championship show where Challenge Certificates were not on offer. Only to be claimed if no Junior Warrant points were gained by that dog by winning a Breed Class or Classes.
- 5 Three points for the award of Best Puppy in Breed at a Championship Show where Challenge Certificates were on offer for the breed. Only to be claimed if no qualifying Junior Warrant points were gained by that dog by winning a Breed Class or Classes at that show and only to be claimed if the dog awarded Best Opposite Sex Puppy has also gained one or more points having won a Breed Class or Classes at that show.
- 6 One point for the award of Best Puppy in Breed at an Open show or a Championship Show where Challenge Certificates were not on offer. Only to be claimed if no qualifying Junior Warrant points were gained by the dog by winning a Breed Class or Classes at that show and only to be claimed if the dog awarded Best Opposite Sex Puppy has also gained one or more points having won a Breed Class or Classes at that show.
- 7 Only one claim can be made where a dog has been declared both Best Puppy in Breed and Best of Breed.
- 8 Junior Warrant holders will be awarded a Stud Book Number.
- 9 The title "JW" may be used after the name of the dog on Show entries and in catalogues.

It is an owners' responsibility to ensure that all information given on this application form is correct. We may at times request evidence to support your claim either as part of random spot checks or as instructed by the Board. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that you keep in your possession copies of marked up catalogues, should you ever need to refer to them to support your application.
