ere at the Kennel Club, we are not underestimating the seriousness of the current situation brought about by the spread of coronavirus. Our thoughts go out to those who have been affected thus far.

In recent weeks, many regional and national canine events have been postponed or cancelled,

while businesses and employees across the UK are already feeling the effects of travel restrictions and reduced incomes.

At the Kennel Club, our job is to ensure

that as we adapt to, tackle and emerge from these unprecedented and challenging times, canine activties can continue to flourish. We are paying close attention to developments and will continue to revise our approach so that we are always best placed to serve the dog world at large.

In response to the crisis, the Kennel Club Charitable Trust has announced that, where it can, it will help support those in the community which require emergency funds in order to prevent the unnecessary suffering of dogs.

In parallel, the Kennel Club Educational Trust will also be

setting up an emergency fund to help support training clubs affected by the negative consequences for dogs, due to Covid-19.

Meanwhile, the Kennel Club

is currently exploring support arrangements for clubs and canine societies worst hit by the outbreak of the virus, particularly those societies affected by cancellations.



We will continue to update our website with the latest advice from Defra and Department of Health to help guide you, and do keep an eye out for more resources and ideas


to keep you and your dogs happy at this time on our social media channels. Of course, our day-to-day work

MAISIE THE DACHSHUND WINS CRUFTS



Best in Show at Crufts 2020 was the Wire Haired Dachshund, Ch Silvae Trademark. Owned by Kim and Duncan McCalmont from Berkeley in Gloucestershire, 'Maisie' is the first Dachshund of any of the breed's six varieties to win this award.

The show attracted an entry of nearly 20,000 dogs and was watched on TV on Channel 4 and More4 where audience figures regularly peaked at 1.8m viewers. All the action from the main arena, including the judging of Best in Show on the Sunday evening, was viewed online on YouTube by a global audience of over 1.5m. The Crufts Extra programme on YouTube was a new venture for Crufts this year and has also been well received, especially

with new audiences. Crufts had a Facebook reach of 29,132,681 people and the number of visitors to the show was 155,000 (a surprisingly buoyant figure given the coronavirus outbreak).

Nearly 400 journalists attended the show, including from all the major national newspapers and TV networks, and with over 2,500 news items made both before and during Crufts. This included coverage which had been achieved as a result of 43 hours of Crufts preview and on event

radio airtime, 50 photocalls and more than 20 press releases generated by the Kennel Club press team.

Press coverage of the event has been largely positive, with much space allocated in the national and regional media to the various canine disciplines and initiatives embraced by the Kennel Club and highlighted at Crufts. Photos of the BIS winner Maisie appeared in a number of newspapers, thus giving high-profile publicity to Crufts and pedigree dogs.

THERAPY DOG LEO WINS FRIENDS FOR LIFE

A Golden Retriever named Leo, owned by Lyndsey Uglow, was announced as the winner of the Kennel Club Friends For Life competition at Crufts 2020.



Leo heads up a team of therapy dogs who visit the Southampton Children's Hospital to provide animal assisted intervention. Leo and friends have been visiting up to five times a week for the past seven years. The team is made up of six dogs and four very experienced handlers and have helped more than 10,000 often critically-ill children.

Leo was one of five hero dogs shortlisted for the

Friends For Life competition in February. The finalists shared their unique stories of the impact that each dog has made on their life, with the nation voting for their favourite. The winner was announced in the Resorts World Arena on the final day of the world's greatest dog show by James Middleton.

The proud owner and deserving dog were presented their award and a cheque for £5,000 from the Kennel Club Charitable

Trust for a dog charity of their choice. The four other finalists also received £1,000 for their chosen dog charity for making it to the prestigious final.

The five dogs which made the 2020 final were selected by a panel of judges from the Kennel Club, where they were chosen for the lifetime of love and loyalty they give to their owners and for the way that they have irrevocably changed their lives.

Mother and daughter team from Doncaster, South Yorkshire won the Kennel Club Breeders' Competition at Crufts. Joan Scarll and her daughter Sue Sykes, whose team comprised Ch Timazinti

Liberty handled by Sue, Ch Timazinti's Kienke handled by Joan, Ch Timazinti's Britskii at Kenida handled by Ida Watts, and Timazinti's Peppermint at Frenchlands JW ShCM ShCEx handled by Lina Schuckardt, won the ultimate breeder's title with their team of Lhasa Apsos.

The team beat 35 other breeders to win the competition which is sponsored by Agria Pet Insurance and has media support from Our Dogs which compiles and publishes the monthly points table.

David Guy was the judge and he selected Joan and Sue's team of Lhasa Apsos for the prize as the breeder with the best overall quality evident in their dogs. Each team comprised three or four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership.

Speaking about the win, Joan said:

"For me, this is the best thing ever. These dogs have won 29 Challenge Certificates between them and I am very proud of that.

"Dog shows are a good hobby to get involved in. They can be a lot of fun when people make them fun. Whether we win or lose, we are always coming home with the best dogs."

Runner-up best breeder was awarded to Kath Storey with her team of Pugs bred under the Rhodenash kennel

name. Third were the Lireva Pomeranians bred by Averil Cawthera-Purdy and fourth were Aileen McDonald's Balgay Tibetan Spaniels.

ENGLISH TOY TERRIER WINS JUNIOR WARRANT COMPETITION

Ch Witchstone Place Your Bets at Capledrae JW, an English Toy Terrier from Fife, owned by Moira and Robert Bennett, won the Junior Warrant Winner of the Year competition final at Crufts 2020.

'Stanley' is nearly two years old and has had a great start to his dog show career, winning the Junior Warrant, an award for pediaree doas from the gaes of 6 to 18 months which have won a series of first prizes at both open and championship dog shows, and has now followed this up with a major win at Crufts at the NEC, Birmingham. Stanley and Moira were up against nine other finalists for the coveted title but they wowed judge Sandra Marshall in the exciting final. This is the second year in a row that an English Toy Terrier bred in the Witchstone kennel has taken the top prize, with last year's winner, Spike,

scoring a double win for breeders, Andy Leonard and Nick Gourley.

The Junior Warrant Winner of the Year competition is held annually and is for dogs which have gained the title of Junior Warrant during the previous

There were heats held throughout the UK in 2019, with five dogs and a reserve selected by the judge at each of the heats. 62 top young dogs and their handlers were then invited to the semi-finals at the Kennel Club's Discover Doas event at ExCeL London. where ten finalists were selected to compete at Crufts.



Runner-up in the Junior Warrant final was the Newfoundland, King Of Helluland Love Actually at Darebear JW, aged two, owned by Abbi and Steve Adair from South Shields, Tyne and Wear.

'TALENT SPOTTED' SUSSEX SPANIEL TAKES VULNERABLE BREEDS TITLE

Sh Ch Yorkham Rocking Rudolph ShCEx, a Sussex Spaniel owned by Susan and John Evans from Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk and handled by Becky Johnson, has won the final of the Kennel Club Vulnerable British and Irish Breeds competition at Crufts.


'Wilbur' was 'talent spotted' by Becky whilst he was out on a walk with his owner John. Becky, an experienced exhibitor herself with Flat-Coated Retrievers, was impressed by Wilbur and helped introduce the pair into the world of dog showing. Little by little, Wilbur made his way to the top by winning a Challenge Certificate and his Show Champion title at last year's Crufts and returning this year to claim the top prize in the Vulnerable Breeds competition.

The Kennel Club Vulnerable British and Irish Breeds competition helps

raise awareness of rare native breeds whose annual puppy registrations stand at fewer than 300, thus leaving them at risk from disappearing from the UK's streets and parks.

Sussex Spaniels are the rarest of the land spaniels and were the most vulnerable breed in the UK in 2018 when only 34 puppies were registered with the Kennel Club. They have since experienced a boost in popularity, with 52 Sussex Spaniel puppies registered in 2019.

Wilbur was chosen by judge Jeff Horswell as having the best overall



quality evident from others dogs in the final. The next day, he won Best of Breed.

The Vulnerable Breeds competition, which was open to all vulnerable breeds competing at designated championship shows, enabled dogs that are on the Kennel Club's vulnerable breeds list to collect points to qualify them for the final at Crufts.

Ch Faynad Frankincense, a Mastiff owned by George Zadeh, was named as Reserve Best Vulnerable Breed. He too won Best of Breed at the show and was shortlisted in the group.

EVENTS AND FIELD TRIALS UPDATE

The safety and security of competitors, spectators, volunteers and staff at Kennel Club events is of paramount importance. KC DOG



The Kennel Club is the largest organisation in the UK devoted to dog health, welfare and training, whose main objective is to ensure

that dogs live healthy, happy lives with responsible owners. As part of its External Affairs activities, the Kennel Club runs a dog owners group KC Dog which was established to monitor and keep dog owners up to date about dog related issues, such as Public Spaces Protection Orders (PSPOs) being introduced across the country and public consultations on animal welfare

Local authorities in England and Wales can use PSPOs, and in Northern Ireland DCOs, to restrict where dog walkers can go with their dog and how they walk their dog (such as having a means to pick up, or having a certain lead length). These restrictions may specify a particular park (or area within the park) where dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, or ban dogs from a beach for specific times of the year. At present, there are no equivalent powers available to local authorities in Scotland.

As a general principle, we would like to highlight the importance that all PSPOs to be necessary and proportionate responses to problems caused by dogs and irresponsible owners. It is also important that authorities balance the interests of dog owners with the interests of other access users. For more information please visit www.kcdog.org.uk

DORSET COUNCIL PSPO

The council are proposing the introduction of a number of measures including:

- Doas must be kept on a lead in public gardens. 30mph zones, within 5 metres of sports pitches, aravevards and cemeteries
- Excluding dogs from playing fields and some parks.
- Implementing a maximum lead length of 2 metres.
- Synchronising the seasonal ban of dogs on beaches across Dorset, and potentially replacing the ban with a dogs on lead order.
