On June 12, the Kennel Club issued the following statement:

The Kennel Club and the Crufts Committee are committed to holding Crufts 2021 if permitted to do so by the Government.

We greatly appreciate the support the show receives each year from our exhibitors, sponsors, trade-stand holders, public visitors and Channel 4.

The qualification criteria for the show will

be announced once the Government guidance is clear on future events, which may not be until the autumn.

It may be that the show will need to be reformatted in a way to comply with new regulations. If so, more details about this will be announced as information becomes available.

We would ask for patience at what is a difficult time for everyone with limited

information currently available as to how things will progress in the coming weeks and months.

Crufts is the world's best known celebration of dogs and we very much look forward to welcoming you all to the show in happier times in 2021, if circumstances allow.

Launched in mid-May to celebrate the joy our four-legged friends bring, and recognising how they are helping their young owners through lockdown, the virtual show was open to YKC members aged 6-24 and showcased a whole variety of impressive tricks and handling techniques, as well as plenty of cute and cuddly pictures.

Despite being stuck at home, 18-year-old Ruby-Mae and Romeo have taken this time as an opportunity to do plenty of training, whether that's heelwork, agility or obedience, which the pair regularly compete in under normal circumstances. The dynamic duo were named the



winners after coming top in the Best Walkies class.

As well as providing young dog lovers with a fun activity to enjoy with their canine friends, the YKC online dog show was initiated to promote the importance of mental and physical stimulation

for dogs during lockdown, celebrate the companionship, love and joy that dogs bring into our lives, as well as providing hundreds of cute puppy pictures for dog lovers everywhere to scroll through.

EXTENSION OF ANNUAL RETURNS DEADLINE TO 31 DECEMBER 2020

The Kennel Club Board has approved a proposal to allow registered clubs and societies to submit their annual returns up until the end of 2020.

The proposal, made by the Shows Executive Committee (SEC), was made in view of the many societies which have been forced to cancel or postpone their annual general meeting (AGM) due to the coronavirus pandemic. The SEC was in agreement that, due to this, a reasonable approach needed to be taken regarding the submission of annual returns and therefore recommended the deadline be extended until the end of the year.

KCET SUPPORTS 14 CAUSES AS KCCT REOPENS EMERGENCY FUND

In April, the Kennel Club, the Kennel Club Educational Trust (KCET) and the Kennel Club Charitable Trust (KCCT) announced their intention to support canine organisations in their communities which may be suffering financial hardship as a result of the coronavirus pandemic.

Following announcements about the KCCT donations, decisions have now been taken to the amount of monies and the organisations which will receive funds donated by the KCET. Support will be given to 14 organisations that applied who are suffering financially as a direct result of the Covid-19 pandemic. These organisations will receive extra funds from the KCET in

order to help safeguard their future.

Recipients of the KCET funds include Fleur's Happy Hounds, K9 Pursuits Ltd, and Pet Behaviour Scotland.

newspaper to support the smaller dog rescue centres and other canine organisations affected by Covid-19.

as suffering with needing to take in dogs and the restrictions of trying to rehome more dogs in lockdown.

JCF to be known as the Judges Education Programme (Breed Shows)

The Judges Competency Framework (JCF) underwent an independent review in 2019 which recommended that a new name be adopted by the framework, without using the word 'competency'. This view was also supported by the findings of the Kennel Club survey on the JCF.

The Kennel Club Board has recently approved a change of name for the JCF. It is now to be known as the

Judges Education Programme (Breed Shows).

Kathryn Mansfield, Kennel Club Secretary, said: "In reaching this decision, the Board was mindful that, as the Kennel Club offers education for all judges, this new name can be adopted across all its licensed activities, for example Judges Education Programme (Agility Shows)."

WARM WEATHER WARNING AMID LOCKDOWN EASING

With record temperatures achieved in May and the warmest summer months ahead of us, a new warning from dog welfare experts has been issued to owners to protect their dogs during the hot weather.

The Kennel Club has teamed up with a coalition of vets, rescue and rehoming charities, police, and welfare organisations to highlight the dangers of warm weather to dogs as part of the annual Dogs Die in Hot Cars campaign.

The easing of lockdown could see more dogs left in cars – which can be fatal in warm weather, the Kennel Club warns. The organisation, which is the largest in the UK dedicated to the health and welfare

of dogs, is urging all owners not to leave their dog in a car, even with the windows down, and to check before you travel – as many usually dog-friendly venues have changed their rules due to Covid-19.

Similarly, with social distancing measures in place, queues can be significantly longer and in many shops and other places, one-way systems are in place, meaning dogs could be left for much longer in vehicles in staggering temperatures.

The organisation has



released practical tips and advice to keep dogs cool at home during the expected hot weather:

- Create a shaded space to keep your dog cool
- Give them a paddling pool to splash around in
- Add ice cubes to their water bowls

- Walk them early morning or evening and avoid the midday sun
- Walk in shaded areas
