'Both the ABB and Bloodhound Club agree that there is no advantage of reintroducing these nominations, and there is no need for this change in the rules I(D).

The Bloodhound Club remains in favour of the second in Intermediate also being qualified to enter Senior, and that a restricted hound should

be allowed to compete on a leash, and be disqualified it if the lead is dropped, as in other stakes. However, there has been little progress on agreeing the procedure suggested at the Review meeting at the Kenel Club over four years ago. it is better that no changes to the current rules are proposed or implemented at the Council meeting, and it is better to delay this until the changes can be made that encourage the next generation.'
