QUALIFICATION:

First place awards gained in the 2020 season will not be carried forward to the 2021/22 Championships. First place awards gained in the 2020 season will continue to contribute to the title of Field Trial Champion (FTCh). All first place awards are confined to Open stakes for which a Field Trial Certificate is awarded to the winner. A society may only host one qualifying stake for each of the 2021/22 Championships.

Qualification for the 2021/22 Championship will be as follows:

- **A First place in an Open Cocker Spaniel Stake which has taken place since 2 February 2021.**

The Winner of the 90th Kennel Club Cocker Spaniel Championship is eligible to compete without qualifying. The Winner of the 2021/22 Irish Cocker Spaniel Championship is eligible to compete.

COVID-19: If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the event and should self-isolate in line with Government advice www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/

Covid PPE – Covid PPE (ie gloves and face masks) **may** be worn by competitors / judges and officials at their own discretion, and PPE will **not** be mandatory for any attendee at the trial.

Armbands – Armbands will be provided by the KC but competitors may provide their own number if they wish to do so, which does not need to be an armband but must be clearly visible.

Cards – Cards for the Championship will be available on the day, but it will not be mandatory for these to be taken.

Prize Cards & Trophies - will be available for the presentation but taking these items is not mandatory.

Track and trace – All competitor contact data will be taken from the entry forms for the purposes of track and trace. Any changes to this data must be reported to the FT Secretary.

Additional Handlers / Spectators - All contact data for additional handlers / spectators must be recorded on each day of the Championship for the purposes of track and trace.

Any individual not following Government Guidelines, or who is deemed to be putting the safety of others at risk will be asked to leave the championship ground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at The Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Kennel Club *reserves the right to refuse any entry.*
3. Substitution of dogs is not allowed.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the trial can be made.
5. Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to The Kennel Club.
6. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of The Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
7. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
8. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express agreement of the Chief Steward and the Host.
9. Welfare of Dogs
An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
10. **Social Media must not be used when on the Championship ground, location tagging must be removed on images. Any photography / videography must be at the permission of the Chief Steward only.**
