Crufts 2022: entries open!

Entries are now open for Crufts which will be making a welcome 'full capacity' return next year to the NEC, Birmingham on 10th-13th March 2022 after a gap of one year due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

The breed competitions are scheduled to take place on the following days:

Thursday 10th March 2022	Working and Pastoral
Friday 11th March 2022	Terrier and Hound
Saturday 12th March 2022	Utility and Toy
Sunday 13th March 2022	Gundog

Among the special features at the 2022 show will be a display in the main arena on the Sunday evening by royal Gundogs to commemorate HM The Queen's Platinum Jubilee, as well as a display on the Sunday evening by the Guide Dogs to mark the ninetieth anniversary of the charity. Hearing Dogs for Deaf People will also hold a display on the Saturday in celebration of their fortieth anniversary year.

Three breeds will be creating history at the 2022 show. Hungarian Pumis will have their own classes

for the first time, Smooth Faced Pyrenean Sheepdogs will make their debut in the Imported Breed Register classes, and Harriers will be making their first appearance in the Crufts breed ring since 1898.

Tragic Vivienne wins Westminster Dog of Year

French Bulldog Vivienne, entered with Sir David Amess before his tragic death, has been crowned Westminster Dog of the Year 2021, recognising Sir David's honourable and extensive work to improve and protect dog welfare throughout his life, as well as his work as an MP in Southend West.

Campaigning on behalf of the UK's dogs, Sir David had entered Westminster Dog of the Year more than a dozen times, having previously entered with his rescue dogs, Lilly and Bo, and raising awareness about the impact of fireworks on pets, lobbying for a ban on electric shock collars and preventing puppy smuggling. Representing Sir David on the day alongside Vivienne were close friends and colleagues Andrew Rosindell MP and Mark Francois MP.

The judging panel - Mark Beazley; Chief Executive at The Kennel Club, Owen Sharp, Dogs Trust Chief Executive and Alex Norris MP; 2018 Winner - spent the morning with dogs from different political persuasions and ambitions and led tributes to Sir David Amess, with speeches from the Rt Hon Lord Benyon.

In second place was Stanley, a Border Terrier owned by Edward Timpson MP for Eddisbury, with a place in the (trophy) cabinet awarded to Henry, a Labrador owned by Selaine Saxby MP for North Devon in third.

In recognition of Sir David Amess' contributions to dog welfare, Vivienne the French Bulldog was also crowned the public's winner of Westminster Dog of the Year 2021, with a staggering number of votes via The Kennel Club's website.

Kennel Club Working Trials Championships: Border Collie and GSD win

WT Ch Glenalpine Fen CDEx - TDEx, a Border Collie owned by Pat Herbert, has won the Tracking Dog Stake for the third time at the Kennel Club Working Trials Championships. The Patrol Dog Stake was won by Jo Quick's Falkenwald High Places CDEx- TDEx, PDEx, a German Shepherd Dog.

Yorkshire Working Trials Society hosted the Championships for the fifth time. The event was sponsored by The Kennel Club and held at the Church Fenton Cricket Club in Tadcaster, North Yorkshire.

The Championships, which were not held in 2020 due to the pandemic, this year saw highly talented working trial dogs put through their paces via a series of exercises to determine the top dogs for both the Tracking Dog (TD) and Patrol Dog (PD) Stakes.

TD judge, Mike Williams, selected the following winners:

- 1st & WT Certificate, Pat Herbert's Border Collie, WT Ch Glenalpine Fen CDEx - TDEx (195.5 points)
- 2nd & Reserve WT Certificate, Chris Theobald's Border Collie, Beverton Nan CDEx - TDEx (195 points)
- 3rd Sarah Burroughes' Labrador Retriever, Tarnedge Hobby CDEx - TDEx
- 4th Julie Atkins' Border Collie, WT Ch Glenalpine Peg CDEx - TDEx

Jaguar wins Kennel Club HPR Championship

Jaguar du Domaine Saint Hubert at Bryantscroft, a Hungarian Wire Haired Vizsla, has won the Kennel Club's Hunt, Point and Retrieve (HPR) Championship 2021, thereby claiming his Field Trial Champion title. Sponsored by Skinner's Pet Foods Field & Trial, the event was held on the North Yorkshire Moors.

The spectacular moorland was the ideal setting for the 15 dogs and handlers to demonstrate their hunting skills and the range of game available really tested the qualified dogs. Every dog was given opportunity to show itself to its best and having the opportunity to run on such special ground was a true privilege.

Jaguar, known at home as Jago and owned and handled by Rory Major, was awarded first place at the competition which saw talented working gundogs from HPR breeds tested on their natural working ability. The judges were Mick Canham and Steve Kimberley.

International Canine Health Awards: nominations open

Now in its tenth year, the famous International Canine Health Awards recognise and celebrate some of the world's finest researchers, scientists and veterinarians, as well as UK veterinary students and breed health coordinators whose work has a positive impact on the health and wellbeing of dogs.

The awards, which are run by The Kennel Club Charitable Trust, include substantial monetary prizes donated by Vernon and Shirley Hill, founders of Metro Bank. The virtual awards ceremony is planned to take place in June 2022 (date to be confirmed), with nominations closing 28 February 2022.

With a prize fund totalling £70,000, The Kennel Club Charitable Trust urges scientists and others throughout the world to nominate world class researchers and clinicians worthy of the International or Lifetime Achievement Awards. Individuals may also nominate themselves. The awards will be judged by an eminent international panel drawn

from the veterinary profession and scientific research.

All nominations must be submitted via the designated Kennel Club Charitable Trust application form and received by 28 February 2022. Separate forms are available for the two UK Student Inspiration Awards and for the UK Breed Health Coordinator Award.

The four awards are:

- International Prize in Canine Health – for outstanding contributions in the field of canine health and welfare, with a prize of £40,000 towards future projects
- Lifetime Achievement Award – with a £10,000 prize, this award will go to a veterinarian or scientist, who has dedicated much of their career to advancing the health and welfare of dogs
- UK Student Inspiration Awards – these comprise postgraduate and undergraduate awards, with prizes of £10,000 and £5,000 respectively to aid further education costs, the

development of their careers, or the creation/continuation of a project

- UK Breed Health Coordinator Award – with a £5,000 prize, judges will be looking for individuals from UK Kennel Club breed clubs or councils who have demonstrated a dedication to supporting health and welfare within their breed over the previous year

The Kennel Club welcomes new criminal offence to tackle dog theft

The Kennel Club has welcomed Government plans recently announced to introduce a specific criminal offence for those who steal dogs.

Set out to be included within the Animal Welfare (Kept Animals) Bill, the new law will see dog theft criminals face up to five years in prison. This follows a successful campaign from the organisation lobbying for stronger sentencing and better data collection on the devastating crime.

Currently, sentencing places undue weighting

on the monetary value of a dog rather than giving sufficient weight to the emotional impact of the crime, meaning it is often treated in the same way as the theft of a laptop or mobile phone.

The Kennel Club has long campaigned on the issue of pet theft, lobbying for sentencing to recognise the emotional value of a dog and for better reporting

and recording from officials so that underlying causes of dog theft can be tackled, and provided evidence as such to the Government's Pet Theft Taskforce, formed in May this year.

The Kennel Club's Paw and Order campaign, launched last summer to urge action from the Taskforce, subsequently illustrated the need for reform and spurred

thousands of dog lovers across the UK to write to their MP. Statistics gathered as part of the campaign showed the failure to tackle a crime that is devastating 196 families every month, as just two per cent of dog theft cases in 2020 resulted in a criminal charge.

AMENDMENTS TO BREED STANDARDS

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendments:

CIRNECO DELL'ETNA

General Appearance Medium sized hunting dog. Elegant, slender build, but strong and robust. Alert, upright ears. Long limbed, of light construction and square outline.

Head and Skull Skull moderately narrow, in profile almost flat. Top of skull and foreface parallel or slightly divergent. Foreface lean and well chiselled. Slight stop. Flat cheeks. Length of muzzle equal to or only slightly less than length of skull. Bridge of nose straight. Nose rather large, flesh coloured, blending with coat.

Eyes Relatively small, oval in shape, semi-lateral position. Amber or ochre, blending with coat colour. Eye rim pigmentation matching nose.

Ears Set very high and close together, erect, rigid and parallel when alert. Triangular shape with narrow tip. Length not more than half the head.

Mouth Perfect, regular and complete scissor bite i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to jaws. Lower jaw not prominent. Thin, taut lips.

Tail Low set, fairly thick at base, reaching to point of hock. Of equal thickness for most of its length. Carried high and gently curved but never over the back, when dog is in action; in repose the tail hangs down in a gentle curve. Hair on tail is slightly longer than on body, but not feathered.

Coat Short on head, ears and legs. Short to moderate length (2.5cms (1in)) on body, but sleek

and close, ranging from fine to slightly harsh. No feathering.

Colour Self-coloured. Light to dark tan. Tan with a mixture of slightly lighter and darker hairs allowed. White markings allowed on chest, toes, head, foreface and tip of tail. Pigmentation in keeping with coat colour. Deep mahogany colour undesirable.

Size Ideal height at shoulder : Dogs 46-50cms (18¼ - 19½ins); Bitches 44-48cms (17¼ - 19ins).

FRENCH BULLDOG

Head and Skull Head square in appearance and in proportion to dog's size. Skull nearly flat between ears, domed forehead. The skin covering the skull and forehead should be supple enough to allow fine wrinkling when the dog is alert. Well defined muzzle, that can clearly be viewed in profile broad, deep and set back, muscles of cheeks well developed. Stop well defined. Lower jaw deep, square, broad, slightly undershot and turned up. Nose black and wide, relatively short, with visibly open nostrils and line between well defined. Lips black, thick, meeting each other in centre, completely hiding teeth. Upper lip covers lower on each side with plenty of cushion, never so exaggerated as to hang too much below level of lower jaw.

Eyes Preferably dark and matching. Moderate size, round, neither sunken nor prominent, showing no white when looking straight forward; set moderately wide apart and on same level as the stop.

Neck Powerful, well arched, of moderate length.

Tail Undocked, set low, thick at root, tapering quickly towards tip, preferably straight, and long enough to cover anus. Never curling over back nor carried gaily.
