The prestigious Championship, which was two years in the planning owing to the pandemic, returned to the spectacular location of Windsor Great Park, one of the Royal Estates, by gracious permission of Her Majesty The Queen.

Handled by Ian Openshaw from Market Drayton, winning spaniel FT Ch Wolferton Drama – known at home as Lissy in honour of Her Majesty – was awarded first place in the competition, which saw talented spaniels tested on their natural working ability.

Speaking about the win, Ian Openshaw said: "Winning the Championship was the greatest day of my life, it is a true honour to handle dogs for Her Majesty and it has been a lifetime ambition to win for the Queen."

"Lissy has always been a very good dog, excellent at all working elements, and she is particularly fantastic on a runner. She used to be a bit of a monkey when she was younger, but she has really come into her own now. She is a great all-rounder."

Kate Broers, Kennel Club Field Trial Secretary, added: "The Championship was a great success

and thanks must go to all who were involved in the planning, preparation and running of the event. Head gamekeeper Peter Clayton and his team prepared the ground wonderfully, which was an impressive setting of ancient woodland and bracken beds.

"The number of competitors and spectators made for a fantastic atmosphere over the two days and having His Royal Highness, The Earl of

Wessex present the awards

made the presentation truly special. Her Majesty was presented with a Kennel Club commissioned portrait of her two Field Trial Champion Cocker Spaniels, and we are delighted that Her Majesty's own bred Cocker Spaniel won the event, making this her first gundog Championship win in any breed.

"Thank you must also go to the judges for their time and expertise when judging the dogs. They handled the two days with patience, understanding and skill."

"Finally, we would also like to express our gratitude to our sponsors, Skinner's Field & Trial. Junior Warrant Competition heats for 2022 announced

The Kennel Club Junior Warrant Competition heats for 2022 have now been announced. All dogs which have received a Junior Warrant between the qualifying period of 1 June 2021 and 31 May 2022 are eligible to compete. The final will take place at Crufts 2023.

This annual competition began in 1998, and is specifically for Junior Warrant winners to compete against each other for the coveted title of the Kennel Club Junior Warrant Winner of the Year award.

Each year, there is a series of qualifying heats at open shows held by general canine societies around the country, during June, July and August.

At each heat, three dogs and one reserve are selected by the judge and 64 dogs from the heats are then invited to the Semi Finals at Discover Dogs at ExCeL London. At Discover Dogs the dogs are exhibited in the main ring in two groups simultaneously and from this, the judges select the ten finalists to go on and compete at the grand final which is held at Crufts, the following March.

Stud Book Bands for 2022 announced

The Kennel Club has announced details of its Stud Book Bands for 2022.

As previously announced, Stud Book Bands are allocated based upon average show entries, using the same formula as for the CC allocation. These new bands have been adjusted so that they are more evenly spread than in previous years, which will have the bonus of providing extra opportunities for dogs to gain Stud Book numbers.

In making this adjustment, the link has also been removed between a breed's Stud Book Band and the minimum requirements for hands-on experience to be considered to award Challenge Certificates for the first time. These numbers will be reviewed regularly by the Judges Committee.

The new stud book bands are effective between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2025 and will be reviewed in 2026 and then at four-yearly intervals.

The judging tiers come into effect for CC nominations received by The Kennel Club from 1 January 2022, and approval via the Judge Education Programme (JEP) route still requires 50 per cent of the numbers listed under the traditional route. Variety breeds retain their numbers as before and are listed separately.

All non-CC breeds are to be classed as tier 2 breeds with the exception of the Catalan Sheepdog, Greenland Dog, Estrela Mountain Dog and Hovawart, which are tier 1 breeds at the request of the breed clubs.

The Kennel Club reminds judges of breed health monitoring process

The Kennel Club has issued a reminder to championship show judges of Breed Watch category two and three breeds that they must complete a judges' breed health monitoring form following an appointment at Challenge Certificate level.

Breed Watch enables anyone involved in the world of dogs, but particularly dog show judges, to note any visible points of concern which they should take into consideration and penalise when judging the breed. This is essential towards preventing the introduction of health and welfare concerns that are detrimental to a dog's wellbeing as well as maintaining high standards of health in the show ring.

To ensure the health and welfare of pedigree dogs continues to improve, The Kennel Club is reminding all judges of category two and three breeds to complete a health monitoring form following CC appointments. The breed

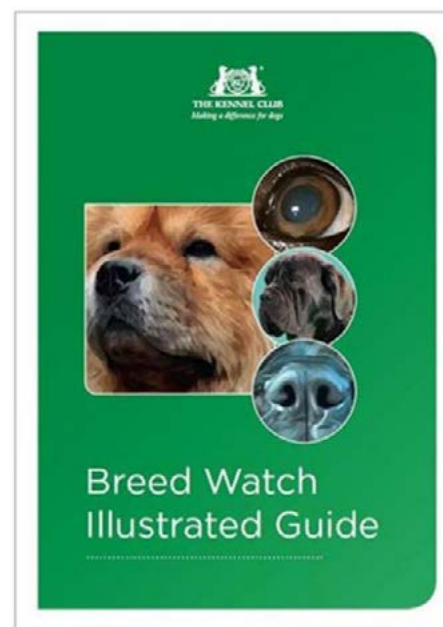
health monitoring form can be found by visiting thekennelclub.org.uk/forms/judges-breed-health-monitoring

This mandatory form plays an integral role in influencing the future development of a breed, as well as contributing to the process of health monitoring. For ease of reference, the online breed health monitoring form is tailored to each category two or three breed and includes each breed's specific points of concern. Once

complete, the online form will be sent to The Kennel Club Health department and reviewed by the Dog Health Group.

Judges are strongly recommended to familiarise themselves with the published breed-specific points of concern prior to their appointment and must complete and send the health monitoring form to The Kennel Club after their appointment. Further information regarding individual breeds and helpful reference materials to assist with the completion of



this mandatory form can be found by visiting thekennelclub.org.uk/BreedWatch

Judges of category one breeds will still be able to access the optional form in the back of the judging book but this will not be applicable to category two or three breeds.

CHANGES TO F (SHOW) REGULATIONS

The Kennel Club has approved the following amendments to the F (show) regulations which will come into effect on 1 January 2022. It should be noted that a number of these amendments were recommendations from The Kennel Club Shows Liaison Council.

F5.b.

A general canine society may apply for a licence for one **two** open shows per year. An application for a second open show licence will be considered if the society's two most recent open shows (at time of application) have achieved an average class entry of 4 dogs or more. For general canine society open shows in Northern Ireland, the average class entry of 3.5 dogs will apply.

NOTE: The class average of 4 dogs is reduced to 3.5 for a two year trial period 1/1/20 – 31/12/21

The Kennel Club SGM - 16th November 2021

The Kennel Club held an SGM on 16th November 2021 at the Curzon Cinema, Curzon Street, Mayfair.

1. The Chairman, Mr A Allcock, chaired the meeting. Item 1 on the agenda was the Chairman's introduction. He introduced the top table and advised that an independent scrutineer, Mi-Voice would oversee the counting of the votes.
2. The Secretary, Mrs KE Mansfield, read the notice convening the meeting at 11.30am.
3. Item 3a on the agenda was to receive an update from the Chairman. The Chairman gave the following update:

'Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to our SGM and thank you for making the journey here today. We are in a very different place to where we were just five months ago. Internally, we started to see the impact of important strategic changes, introduced to help us deal with some of the challenges we have encountered over the past year and to lay essential foundations for the future, which Mark (the Chief Executive) will touch on later.

And of course, in the wider dog world, dog shows and activities are now in full swing. Southern Counties blazed the trail and since then other championship dog shows, field and working trials and obedience and agility events, including the International Agility Festival, have all been taking place and attended by thousands of dog lovers. Thanks to staff and volunteers working behind the scenes and at these events for their resilience and hard work and to everybody who has shown their positivity and support.

Back at Clarges Street and Aylesbury, we are now operating with a hybrid work structure, enabling staff to work flexibly between home and the office, reflecting our values as a future focused, modern workplace. This is a way of working that we continue to review, in order to assess its effectiveness for members of staff, but I think it is safe to say, so far, so good.

We are also extremely pleased to be seeing members back at Clarges Street, enjoying the facilities on offer. We have recently seen the launch of the exhibition *For the Love of Dog/Pour l'Amour du Chien* in The Kennel Club Gallery, which showcases the works of renowned dog photographer, Shirley Baker and since September, we have seen the Club reopen again five days per week.

We are particularly pleased that we were able to host a special surprise celebration in the Club last week for two of our honorary life members – Len Anness and Jimmy Keizer – who have both recently celebrated their 90th birthdays. The surprise lunch was a chance to thank them for their sterling work as volunteer tour guides of our Clarges Street facilities, where they have both shared their knowledge and insight into The Kennel Club's art collection and into dogs and canine culture in general. Both gentlemen's contributions – as well as their kindness, sense of fun and generosity of spirit – are deeply valued by our organisation, as are the contributions of all of our passionate and invaluable volunteers. Both gentlemen are here today so could you join me in giving them a big round of applause.

Whilst we are on the topic of landmark celebrations, we would also like to note that it

is our Patron's Platinum Jubilee next year and The Kennel Club will be sending out very best wishes to Her Majesty.

In many ways, then, we are pleased that we are getting back to some semblance of business as usual, but we are also grateful for the opportunities this time has afforded for us to reflect on the future. We are not immune to the lessons that were learned about what is possible and necessary to live and do business in the modern world, and about what this means to us, as an organisation. As the national tagline goes, we're back and we want to build it back better.

For us, there is no better time to do this, as we look ahead to our anniversary celebrations in 2023 – an anniversary marking 150 years of our Club's history. This is truly a time to celebrate our heritage and all that we have achieved, and to turn our heads to what we need to do to thrive in the future. So what precisely will those celebrations and that future look like? We have set up a working group to drive the exciting discussions about how we mark and celebrate this anniversary and we will have more news over the coming year about what there is to look forward to.

One aspect of the celebrations will certainly involve a special gallery exhibition – a cultural heritage collection of photos, anecdotes and memories, which tells the personal stories of why we are all here – for our dogs. As such the library and gallery is making an appeal for you, the members, to send a memory and, if possible, a photo of a dog that has been meaningful to you. It could be your first dog from childhood or in your own right, the dog that got you started in showing or canine sport, your first prize-winner, your top-winning dog or simply your favourite as a friend and companion over the years. More details will follow on how to submit this, over email and in the Kennel Gazette.

The gallery is just one of The Kennel Club's assets that is valued by members – the Club is another, and there is no doubt that the Club team will be very much a part of the discussions about a fitting celebration for members. At the forefront of our minds is to host a memorable event that is inclusive, so that everybody who wants to attend can do so, which is why we are now exploring the option for something hosted outdoors, in the style of a garden party, in the summer months – rather than hosting an event in April as I've previously spoken about – so watch this space for more information soon. I should also mention at this juncture that Club Manager, Kris Bethune, left the Kennel Club last week, but you will be ably served by the rest of the Club team and we will be looking at our staffing options in the New Year.

Looking ahead, we will be engaging with members over the coming months to understand what your ambitions are for our Mayfair hospitality facilities in the future.

Understanding the wants and needs of our membership will be critical to our strategy and the development of what these facilities have to offer you going forward. We should also explore the potential they afford us for broadening our reach. These are very early discussions but we are confident that we can, together, find a good path between maintaining the special feel of the Club for you, the members, and enhancing what is on offer, whilst also discussing the future use

of these facilities, as a means of reaching out to new audiences.

Of course, whilst we must look at how to celebrate and develop our valuable facilities, we have all been reminded during the pandemic about the occasional precariousness of physical spaces – and have had to, whether we've wished to or not, rely on the digital and virtual world like never before. It is with this in mind that our other facilities, such as the Library, are looking at plans to digitise the whole Stud Book, and potentially the BRS too, in time for the 150th anniversary of The Kennel Club in 2023 – giving access to our unique resources at any time, to dog enthusiasts and researchers from all over the world.

In a similar vein, I am also pleased to announce today that we will be launching a new Facebook group for members – a closed community that enables members to keep up to date with the latest Kennel Club news and events. Only members can be admitted to the closed group and be able to see the content, which will include updates such as forthcoming Club events and menus, in addition to relevant news and information. More information will follow shortly on how to join the group and we encourage as many of you as possible to do so. For those who are not on Facebook, we are also looking at changes to the members' area of our website so that this information is also posted in the online members' zone. We hope that you enjoy and feel the benefit of these online communities.

Finally I wanted to take a positive look our Trusts – The Kennel Club Charitable Trust and Kennel Club Educational Trust – and the role that they play in helping us to achieve our aim of making a difference for dogs and supporting areas that are relevant to the modern dog owner and enthusiast.

In particular, The Kennel Club Charitable Trust has been involved in some crucial initiatives that are transforming the health of brachycephalic dogs, work which is particularly important given the astronomical increase in popularity of some breeds, such as the French Bulldog in recent times. The Kennel Club Charitable Trust in 2020 pledged over £500k, 50% funded by a donation from The Kennel Club, to help advance research into brachycephalic dog health and support future research into Brachycephalic Airways Obstructive Syndrome in 13 more breeds at the University of Cambridge.

The Kennel Club Genetics Centre, formerly at the Animal Health Trust, was also relaunched in partnership with the University of Cambridge Vet School, affording opportunities for collaboration and enhanced insights across a wide range of canine medical conditions. We have also seen the launch of the Charitable Trust's new initiative, Double the Pawprint, which is its first ever matched-giving programme. A longstanding supporter of the Trust generously offered to double every donation up to the value of £100,000, by the end of December this year, so if members are looking to make a pre-Christmas donation to the Trust, now would be a good time for your donation to work harder than ever before.

In respect of The Kennel Club Educational Trust, it will continue to fund and support the YKC Young Person of the Year award at Discover Dogs in November and the Young Handler of the Year award at Crufts and it granted a travel

bursary towards the cost of competing in the Junior Agility World Championship in Finland in 2020, which has been rolled over to 2022.

We cannot talk today, as we have been, about the movement to digital and online systems and the shape of the next 150 years for our organisation, without recognising the fundamental importance of young people to our future – and how The Kennel Club appeals to and maintains our relevance to young people and all dog owners, breeders and enthusiasts, will be part of our strategy going forward, which Mark will talk about shortly.

To close, and in the spirit of engagement and inclusivity, we are looking at the future format of these meetings and whether members would be better served with a KC Members' Forum, following the huge success of an event of this nature at Stoneleigh some years ago. SGMs are usually called to deal with urgent matters, often concerning company management issues that may come up prior to an AGM or to effect any constitutional changes to the Articles of Association. A meeting in November is not an 'automatic or constitutional event' although out of prudence we do provisionally reserve a date in the annual calendar, but a Members' Forum could create more lively, interactive and personal experience.

In my experience, such opportunities have been well received and valuable ideas are engendered from such a forum. This will be particularly important as part of our strategic reset, enabling strong engagement with the membership to ensure full participation in all such discussions. Furthermore, I would also like to remind members to keep in mind that the Board elections are coming up at the next AGM, so it is a chance to think about the shape of your Board and how you would like it to look in the future.'

Item 3b was to receive an update from the Chief Executive. Mr Mark Beazley gave the following update:

'It is so lovely to see people face-to-face here today, and to have the opportunity to talk to you in person about the highlights, challenges and future plans of The Kennel Club. I have seen first-hand this year the immense resilience, hard work and talent within the organisation, which has enabled us to achieve some impressive results and lay important foundations for greater successes yet to come.

I am a bit of a naval history fan so forgive the analogies but it's fair to say that there have been some rough waters over the past year but our ship has certainly been steadied, and whilst some ripples will still be felt, we are definitely now in calmer seas. That is not to say that we are complacent but we are now very much focused on the horizon – on taking control of where we want to go and what we want to achieve – and navigating the best possible route for getting there. As Tony has rightly said, the pandemic afforded all of us the opportunity to adapt, change and reflect and that, coupled with our 150th anniversary celebrations in 2023, means that there has never a better time to celebrate our heritage and past and reflect carefully on our future vision.

To that end we have put in place some crucial initiatives and structural changes to tackle the challenges, but before I go into any of that detail today, I first, in the spirit of celebration, wanted to share with you some of the highlights

from the past few months, since we met at the AGM. Across all corners of our work, we have been busily and successfully achieving our goal of making a difference for dogs, which is, after all, what motivates us all every day that we come to work.

Firstly, I am pleased to announce that in recent months we have been shortlisted for not one but three PR industry awards for our Puppywise campaign. As you may know, this has become a powerful campaign over the years that informs puppy buyers about how to choose and source a puppy responsibly. This year the campaign had an Advertising Value Equivalent of £3.4 million through 903 pieces of coverage – with key highlights including coverage in most of the major national newspaper titles. It is easy to be blindsided by figures but I can safely say that these are not easy results to obtain.

At the AGM I touched upon the great work of our public affairs team in influencing policy decisions that affect dogs and dog breeders. Amongst other successes they have persuaded the Scottish Government to drop the 'business test' licensing threshold from their new dog breeding regulations. Since the AGM, the team presented to the Pet Theft Taskforce, which resulted in all our policy asks being included in the taskforce's recommendations. Again, this work was complemented by a successful and hard-hitting publicity campaign, called 'Paw and Order'.

I also had the real privilege of attending our annual Westminster Dog of the Year event a few weeks ago, jointly hosted with Dogs Trust, which is an opportunity to network with MPs on important topics. The event was especially poignant this year following the tragic death of MP Sir David Amess, whose dog, Vivienne was entered into and won the competition. It was wonderful to hear positive feedback for how the event was run from all those involved. We saw 23 MPs enter and 10 MPs take part with 11 dogs, and hundreds of items of news coverage – it is events like this that make The Kennel Club relevant and put us where we need to be, in terms of the important conversations taking place about dog ownership.

We are also leading the way in terms of our health work and the team has been working tirelessly on new and existing initiatives to better understand and improve breed health and this work has been truly wide ranging. Accessible and affordable health testing tools are absolutely key to helping breeders make informed decisions and, just recently, another five breeds have been able to benefit from the CombiBreed packages that we launched with Weatherby's last year, bringing the total number of breeds these are available to, to 66. It is so heartening to know that, since launching the scheme, almost 7,000 results have been recorded for KC registered dogs and we've seen a 43 percent increase in orders over the last 12 months.

I have also been delighted in recent months to go along to some of our licensed shows and activities and to see how well attended and organised they have been – and to see people and dogs back and doing what they love. Having missed out on seeing this first-hand when I joined last October, it's been a real highlight for me, to see people's enthusiasm, passion and dedication. Behind the scenes, staff and committees have been providing continued support, which includes offering guidance in

relation to the changing Covid situation. And going forward, we are excited that The Kennel Club will be hosting the Junior Open Agility World Championships in 2023, followed by the European Open Agility Championships in 2024.

I would now like to take this opportunity to say how much we appreciate people's patience in relation to the current delays for awards certificates, for which we of course apologise. I am very aware of the frustrations caused by these and other delays since the launch of our new IT system last October and it is in respect of this that we introduced the roadshow stand to Darlington dog show with a focus on assisting with registration support. We have since announced a series of dates for 2021/2022, where this service will be available to help our customers, on the ground. Our next roadshow stand will be at Discover Dogs, taking place at the ExCeL Centre in London on 20-21 November.

This face-to-face support is so important, as I am very aware of how distant The Kennel Club may have felt at times, to those experiencing issues. Our staff have lived, breathed and slept this over the last year, in order to bring things back on track and I am pleased to say that since the last AGM we have seen the positive impact of a significant operational restructure, coupled with a staff training programme. Processing times for registrations have also been sped up due to a series of behind-the-scenes changes to the Kennel Club's IT system, driven by our digital transformation team.

I know that, despite these improvements, there are still challenges in terms of contact and communication – and our priority is to ensure that all those who need to reach us can do so.

Our digital transformation team are also working through a plan to bring further improvements to our website. We have been listening to your views and have made changes, including the launch of our enhanced Find a Judge service and we will be bringing Find a Club, Find a Rescue and Find a Show services back online soon.

On the financial front, we have enjoyed two highly successful years with exceptional levels of activity driven by the pandemic puppy buying boom – across registrations, Petlog and elsewhere – with our costs also lower in lockdown due to furlough and building closures.

Whilst this has significantly helped the Club's cash position, looking forward the financial position is looking less favourable. Tim Hutchings, Chair of the Finance Committee and Mark Johnstone, our CFO, addressed this at the AGM and my message today builds on their presentation back in June.

We expect registration activity levels to fall back to pre-pandemic numbers in 2022. In addition, our costs will be impacted by inflation approaching 4 per cent as well as the National Insurance rise to fund health and social care, and we also need to fund The Kennel Club pension scheme deficit. Indeed, the 2022 draft budget, to be considered by the Board next week, shows the Club only breaking even next year, even with all the improvements we are making that I described earlier.

The boom in puppy buying during the pandemic has, inevitably, led to many new dog owners across the UK, and to an overall increase in UK spend on pets. All this change is increasing the competitive pressures we are feeling from other organisations, whether that is around

dog training, digital competition from the likes of Pets for Homes, or brand and marketing investment by the likes of Dogs Trust. I can reassure you however that the Board, Executive and I are very well aware of these challenges, and the decisions that will need to be made to keep The Kennel Club finances on an even keel.

It is on the note of strategy development that I would like to close. I have spent the past year immersing myself in every aspect of The Kennel Club's work and quite honestly, the length and breadth of what we do is staggering, and we should be immensely proud of that fact and of our rich heritage. It is of course important that we are empowered by this and that we build upon and enhance what we do, rather than being constrained by it. We need to ensure that all parts of the whole are working together in a complementary way, and that we are not afraid to make changes and do things differently in order to achieve our primary aims and ensure our ongoing financial stability.

That is why, in the pipeline, is a fresh vision and strategy for The Kennel Club for the years ahead. Driven together by the Board and the Executive, this important and future focused project will take The Kennel Club to a more healthy and sustainable position for the future and will help us to deliver even more successfully on our mission of making a difference for dogs.

This work is already underway as we have recently created a new role within the organisation – Head of Strategy, Planning and Insight. Mark Bermingham, who has extensive experience in the financial and charitable sectors, has been appointed to the role, and will be working with staff and the Board, as well as drawing on the knowledge and experience of you, our Members and other key stakeholder groups, to develop our vision, strategy and the resulting implementation plans. By the end of this year, we will have agreed the scope and overarching outcomes we want the strategy development programme to deliver by the end of 2022.

Across the spectrum of all that The Kennel Club does, we will be looking at what we are doing well and where we need to have confidence that change can help us to do things even better. In terms of implementation, we will also need to look at the governance and management structures we have in place currently, asking how we can make committees and working parties stronger and more meaningful to help us deliver our vision and strategy for the future.

One thing we are very clear about is that we can only build our path ahead from a position of knowledge, and so it will be crucial for us to conduct quality research and to engage with every one of our stakeholders, with you, the Members, being absolutely key. This will enable us to get a full understanding of where we are now; of the changing needs of dog competitors, owners and breeders and an understanding of where our competitors and partners are heading. From this position of knowledge, having built a keen sense of collective ambition for the future, we hope to be in a position to present our new strategy to you by next autumn, with the expectation that we will then 'hit the ground running' from January 2023.

I am excited about the future – about celebrating, building upon and enhancing all

that we have and embracing new ways of doing things – working with staff, the Board, you, the members, and our other stakeholders. As a final thought, it is the combination of the old and the new; of heritage and change; of taking all that we currently know, have learned and benefit from and twinning that with a fearless approach to the future, that will ultimately be our superpower. It is our duty and privilege, as staff and members, to ensure that The Kennel Club is thriving and making a difference for dogs and safeguarding pedigree dogs and our sport for the next 150 years and beyond.'

Following the updates, comments were addressed on Scottish breeding legislation, non-breed standard colours, and past discussions on the possible registration of all dogs.

4. The Chairman then turned to item 4 of the agenda, which was a proposal on behalf of the Board it is proposed that Mr M Cooke be elected as an Honorary Life Member of the Kennel Club in recognition of his dedication and service given to the Club over the years. The Chairman put the proposal to a vote and the results of the proxy votes were taken into account. There was support, both from the floor and the proxy votes, for the proposal, which was formally passed.
5. Item 5 on the agenda was a proposal on behalf of the Board to seek approval to grant security over the Club's Aylesbury property as collateral for its obligations to the Kennel Club Staff Pension Scheme. The Chairman invited the Chief Financial Officer, Mr Mark Johnstone, to outline the proposal. Following Mr Johnstone's brief presentation, comments and questions were addressed on a number of technical details. The Chairman then put the proposal to a vote and the results of the proxy votes were taken into account. There was support, both from the floor and the proxy votes, for the proposal, which was formally passed.
6. Item 6 was to receive a presentation entitled 'Looking Ahead Together'. The Chairman invited Mr Frank Kane to give the presentation. Mr Kane, as chairman of the newly formed Non-Breed Standard Colours Working Party, gave a presentation on the working party's planned review of the issues surrounding non-breed standard colours. Following the presentation, comments and questions was addressed on the registration of non-breed standard colours, health issues and crossbreeding.

The Chairman then thanked the members and declared the meeting closed.
