

International Agility Festival 2014 Report

- The arrangements for the International Agility Festival to be held at Rockingham Castle from 7-10 August 2014 are progressing well.
- The Kennel Club would like to thank the International Agility Festival's principle sponsor, CSJ Specialist Canine Feeds, for its continued support.
- The Festival is celebrating its 10th Anniversary by extending the event to four days and achieving Championship Status for Small, Medium and Large dogs.
- Alongside welcoming the Olympia Semi-Finals to their new home, the Kennel Club is pleased to host a new Special International Class for its overseas visitors as well as more standard class opportunities.
- It is expected that the show layout would be similar to 2013.
- Camping is limited and is full on ISS (www.iShowServices.com). However, a waiting list is being held and competitors will be allocated camping if pitches become available.
- Petrol generators are also permitted for campers and trade stands, but strict time restrictions will be in place.
- "First Contact" is the main agility equipment supplier and will be supplying rubber chip contacts in all rings.
- Premier Agility Equipment will still be supplying all the Kennel Club equipment in the main ring, which will also be using rubber chip contacts.
- An Event Medical Team including a paramedic will be in attendance again this year.
- There will be 31 trade stands and four catering stands present.
- The Companion Dog Show will be held on Saturday 9 August 2014 and further information can be found on the Kennel Club website.
