

Regulation G.30 Management

e. Where the entry for Championship Class C exceeds 60, it will be reduced to 60 by a ballot based on a system of merit conducted by the Kennel Club.

To calculate the merit score for the dog, points are allocated for places gained at previous shows on the following scale:-

	1st	2nd	3rd	4th
Open Class C	5 points	3 points	2 points	1 point
CH. Class C	20 points	12 points	8 points	4 points
Crufts Obed	30 points	18 points	12 points	6 points

Points are calculated for placing between the date on which previous wins are calculated for entry to the Show (i.e. seven days before the closing date for entries) and the same date ONE year earlier.

Competitors not having given a merit score will be considered as having none. The merit score for all competitors in Championship Class C will be on display at the Show. Competitors claiming an incorrect merit score must be reported to the Kennel Club.

g. Ballot for Running Orders.

(1) A draw for the running order in Championship Class C must be made prior to the Show. The Kennel Club will conduct the ballot for this running order and Show secretaries must forward the names of the exhibitors and dogs involved, together with their merit scores, to the Kennel Club by recorded delivery, registered post or e-mail within seven working days of the closing of entries.

(2) Where the draw makes provision for reserve competitors they should not be substituted before 12 noon on the day of the Show and they shall be worked consecutively after the first 60 dogs have been called to work. Reserve competitors in attendance at the Show and excluded by the Regulations from the final running order shall receive a refund of their entry fee for the class.
