(ABC)**



**AGILITY COMPETITIONS
RULES 2026 (CRUFTS 2027)**



A: HANDLERS

1. The following twelve subcategories will be open for members to compete in:

2. Only current YKC members may compete in YKC Classes.
3. Handlers may not be swapped after the closing date of the show.
 - i. This means no on-the-day swapping of YKC handlers at any ABC qualifier.
 - ii. If the entered handler is not running the dog, that entered dog must withdraw from the class.
4. Use the YKC member's age on the first day of the show to work out which age category a YKC member should enter.

B: DOGS

1. To enter the YKC ABC class, dogs must **NOT** be a Border Collie / crossbreed that includes Border Collie
 - i. The designation: "Working Sheepdog" is counted as a Border Collie
 - a. Rough Collie, Smooth Collie, Bearded Collie & Australian Shepherd are not classed as Border Collies and are therefore eligible to enter this competition
 - ii. A crossbreed that has characteristics of a Border Collie will be asked to prove that there are no Border Collie in the breeding going back 5 generations.
 - iii. A crossbreed that has unknown lineage will count as a Border Collie if it has characteristics that are associated with a Border Collie
2. The judge of the competition will adjudicate any queries regarding the eligibility of the dog
3. Standard Kennel Club rules regarding which dogs may enter this agility class apply.
4. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in any YKC agility competition.
5. Once a dog has competed with a given YKC handler in a ABC qualifier, that dog may only compete with that handler in any future ABC qualifiers for the rest of the qualifying season.
6. Dogs of any grade may enter this competition.

C: ABC QUALIFIERS & GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. **By entering a YKC qualifier, the YKC member and anyone representing them (parent/guardian etc) agree to abide by the YKC's Code of Conduct**
2. The qualification period for **Crufts 2027** is: **01-Nov-2025 till 31-Oct-2026**
3. Unless otherwise specified in this document, YKC ABC Agility classes will be subject to all in-force Kennel Club regulations for agility competitions. Including, but not limited to:
 - i. (H) General Regulations for Agility Competitions
 - ii. (O) Regulations for The Young Kennel Club
4. To determine the results for this class, dogs will be ranked first by total number of faults, then by time. The dog with the fewest faults in the fastest time is the winner.
 - a. The rankings of the 12 subcategories are separate.
5. The ABC qualification class will feature a single agility round.
 - i. The course will be set at approx. G3 standard
6. Standard Kennel Club marking will apply.
7. There will be a prize giving ceremony.
8. Members may enter ABC competitions even if they have already qualified.
9. YKC ABC qualifiers are listed on the YKC website
 - i. Only qualifiers listed on the YKC website will be eligible for qualification, please ensure that you are entering a valid YKC qualifier.



D: ABC WHO QUALIFIES FOR THE FINAL?

1. **First place at any ABC qualifier during this season will guarantee a space in the final**
 - i. There will be no roll-down of this qualification
2. The YKC reserves the right to amend this qualification method if we are vastly oversubscribed for the final at Crufts **OR** if not enough spaces were filled.
 - i. The YKC will only amend qualification criteria in exceptional circumstances.
3. Once qualified, the handler and dog combination is locked in for this year's qualifying season
 - i. The qualified dog may only be handled at Crufts by the same handler that it qualified with
4. The YKC will invite all those who have qualified to enter Crufts via email before Christmas

E: HOW MANY DOGS CAN I QUALIFY FOR ABC?

1. You may qualify as many different dogs across as many heights as you wish for the ABC final at Crufts
HOWEVER:
 - i. YOU MAY ONLY ENTER A MAXIMUM OF **ONE** QUALIFIED DOG ACROSS ALL HEIGHTS **E.G.:**
 - a. **CORRECT** - 1 x dog in large OR intermediate OR medium OR small
 - b. **INCORRECT** - 1 x dog in each height category
2. A handler is only allowed to swap dogs if they have managed to qualify another dog in the ABC competition, in this case, they may swap to the other qualified dog.
 - i. This must be reported to the YKC at the earliest opportunity.
 - ii. The cut off for any substitution of entered dogs using this method is 7 days prior to the first day of Crufts.

F: ABC AT CRUFTS – FINAL

1. **By entering a YKC class, the YKC member and anyone representing them (parent/guardian etc) agree to abide by the YKC's Code of Conduct**
2. At Crufts, the YKC will calculate the which age category each competitor shall be in based on the YKC members age on the first day of Crufts.
 - i. This may be a different age category to the one the YKC member qualified in.
 - ii. Handlers who turn 25 before the first day of Crufts are not eligible to compete at Crufts in the YKC ring – any qualifications gained for the YKC will be forfeit.
3. The final for the YKC ABC Agility competition is held at Crufts in the YKC ring.
4. The final will be held over a single Agility Course.
 - i. This course will be set at grade 3.
5. At Crufts, dogs **MUST** run in strict running order;
 - i. if you are not on the line when your run is due, you will have missed your run.
 - a. The running order for the final will be determined randomly.
 - (1) Each of the heights will be grouped together, but the age categories will be jumbled.



G: CLOTHING, SPONSORSHIP & LOGOS @ CRUFTS

1. Agility handlers should wear smart athletic wear, with plain black or navy tracksuit bottoms/leggings paired with a short sleeve t-shirt/polo shirt of their choosing.
2. Agility handlers should wear footwear that will enable them to run without slipping on artificial grass.
3. Some YKC members have managed to arrange personal sponsorship and branding deals. YKC members who wish to have branding on their clothing at Crufts must follow the below rules.
4. The YKC & Kennel Club also have several sponsors in both the YKC ring and the main arena at Crufts.
 - i. To comply with our sponsors, YKC members may **NOT** have branding on display from the following companies:
 - a. Dog food or treat supplier
 - b. Car manufacturer
 - c. Insurance company
 - ii. If a YKC member wishes to have branding from a company not on the above list on an item of clothing, that company's branding must be where a breast pocket would be and must be approximately breast pocket size.
 - iii. This restriction on branding only applies in the following locations:
 - a. Crufts YKC collecting ring, Crufts YKC ring, Crufts YKC Presentation Area.
 - b. Crufts Main arena collecting ring, Crufts Main Arena, Crufts Main Arena Presentation Area.

H:

ABC FINAL – PRIZEGIVING

1. The following awards will be presented in the YKC ring for the ABC Final

2. All non-placed competitors will receive a finalist rosette when exiting the prize-giving
 - i. To receive this award, members must be present for the prize-giving.
