## Does your dog follow the 'petiquette' rules...?

We love dogs and know that they are members of your family, so they are welcome inside our premises. We just ask that you bear in mind the following 'petiquette' tips, to ensure that we can keep on welcoming your four legged friends, time and again...

- Make sure that your dog is clean and flea free before entering the premises.
- Make sure that your dog is house trained.
- Make sure that you always clean up after your dog - it is your responsibility!
- Make sure that your dog is well trained and that it will sit, stay and come on command.
- Make sure that your dog doesn't disturb others by barking.
- Not everybody will love your dog as much as you do - make sure that it does not jump up at or pester other people.
- Dogs are allowed in areas that serve and sell food at the proprietor's discretion but they must stay out of food preparation areas.
- Do not allow your dog to touch other people's food.
- It is a good idea to take a pet carrier with you when you are staying somewhere overnight or for long periods. Turn it into your dog's 'den', with his own bedding and toys, so that he will settle down well.
- Keep towels handy to wipe muddy paws.
- Don't leave your dog unattended.
