



## German Pinscher

### Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 4 living dogs & 1 deceased dog.

#### Mortality results

A total of 1 death was reported, representing 0.02% of all deaths reported in the Pedigree Breed Health survey. The age for the German Pinscher was 10 years. Table 1 shows the causes of death for the breed.

#### Morbidity results

The 4 live German Pinschers represented 0.01% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 1.5 years (Table 2). Of the 4 German Pinschers which the survey covers, 4 had reported no conditions and 0 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 0 condition(s), max = 0 conditions), giving a total of 0 incidents of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for German Pinschers are shown in Table 3. There were 4 dogs with responses for Body Condition displayed in Table 4.
