Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 4 living dogs & 1 deceased dog.

Mortality results

A total of 1 death was reported, representing 0.02% of all deaths reported in the Pedigree Breed Health survey. The age for the Greyhound was 10 years.

Morbidity results

The 4 live Greyhounds represented 0.01% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 6 years (Table 2). Of the 4 Greyhounds which the survey covers, 3 had reported no conditions and 1 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 1 condition(s), max = 1 conditions), giving a total of 1 incidents of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for Greyhounds are shown in Table 3. There was 1 dog with a response for Body Condition displayed in Table 4.

The age the dog was first affected by a condition was 2 years. Table 5 shows the reported disease conditions for the Greyhound.

From the dogs surveyed, most Greyhounds were not affected by a disease condition (75.00%). There was only one reported disease condition in live dogs which was unspecified muscle, bone or joint condition. The only reported cause of death was bone tumour.
