



Havenese

Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 41 living dogs & 0 deceased dogs.

Mortality results

There were no reported deceased Havenese.

Morbidity results

The 41 live Haveneses represented 0.09% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 2 years (Table 2). Of the 41 Haveneses which the survey covers, 29 had reported no conditions and 12 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 1 condition(s), max = 4 conditions), giving a total of 20 incidents of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for Haveneses are shown in Table 3. There were 39 dogs with responses for Body Condition displayed in Table 4.

The median age the dogs were first affected by a condition was 0 years (min = 0 years, max= 4 years). Table 5 shows the reported disease conditions for the Havenese.

Summary

From the dogs surveyed, most Haveneses were not affected by a disease condition (70.73%). There were three most commonly reported disease condition representing an equal proportion of live dogs; these were blocked tear ducts, harvest mite (chigger) dermatitis and umbilical hernia. There were no reported deaths.
