Summary

From the dogs surveyed, most Otterhounds were affected by a disease condition (52.00 %). The most commonly reported disease condition in live dogs was skin (cutaneous) cyst. There were only two reported causes of death that represented an equal proportion of the deaths; these causes were kidney failure and temperament (unspecified).
