Schipperke

Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 19 living dogs & 1 deceased dog.

Mortality results

A total of 1 death was reported, representing 0.02% of all deaths reported in the Pedigree Breed Health survey. The age for the Schipperke was 6 years.

Morbidity results

The 19 live Schipperkes represented 0.04% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 5 years (Table 2). Of the 19 Schipperkes which the survey covers, 15 had reported no conditions and 4 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 1 condition(s), max = 2 conditions), giving a total of 5 incidents of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for Schipperkes are shown in Table 3. There were 19 dogs with responses for Body Condition displayed in Table 4.

The median age the dogs were first affected by a condition was 2 years (min = 0 years, max= 6 years). Table 5 shows the reported disease conditions for the Schipperke.

From the dogs surveyed, most Schipperkes were not affected by a disease condition (78.95 %). The most commonly reported disease condition in live dogs was ocular (eye) discharge. The only reported cause of death was surgical complications.
