Sloughi

Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 5 living dogs & 0 deceased dogs.

Mortality results

There were no responses for deceased Sloughis.

Morbidity results

The 5 live Sloughis represented 0.01% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 6 years (Table 2). Of the 5 Sloughis which the survey covers, 4 had reported no conditions and 1 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 1 condition(s), max = 1 conditions), giving a total of 1 incident of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for Sloughis are shown in Table 3. There were 0 dogs with responses for Body Condition.

The median age the dogs were first affected by a condition was 4 years (min = 4 years, max= 4 years). Table 5 shows the disease conditions for the Sloughi.
