Rejected by WTLC

Small dogs to be able to progress to TD with their reduced

Jumps to be progressed in size through the stakes, allowing for reduced jumps in early stakes

Pre CD Stakes (without agility) to be recognised by the KC and allow formal qualifications for younger / less experienced dogs

Progression of down stay format through the early stakes

No response from most Reps

All societies were asked to contribute with ideas for how WT could progress and grow in light of concerns raised over the low trial entries

Improve communication within the WT community over Liaison Council matters via social media, in a similar format to that of Obedience & Agility
