Interim Breed Standards for Hungarian Mudi and Pyrenean Mastiff published

The Kennel Club Interim Breed Standards for the Hungarian Mudi (Imp) and Pyrenean Mastiff (Imp) were published on 1 October 2025. Both breeds are now eligible for exhibition in Imported Breed Register classes from this date. The standards are now available on the **Kennel Club website**.

The Hungarian Mudi is a rare Hungarian shepherding breed with a rich history. Though references to Mudi-like dogs date back to the 18th century, it wasn't until 1936 that the breed was formally identified and is known for its distinctive traits: a curly coat, erect ears, and exceptional intelligence. It is used for herding large livestock and flushing wild boar and is an excellent guard and companion dog.

The Pyrenean Mastiff was once known as the Navarra Mastiff as it was developed in the Pyrenean region between Aragon and Navarra. The breed is of the Molosser family and has always been used as a flock guardian, protecting their herds from predators such as the wolf and bear. Like all of the Molosoid breeds, the Pyrenean Mastiff is large and powerful. Wonderfully loyal to his master and family he had adapted well to modern life and his role of guardian of the home.

The Hungarian Mudi (Imp) has been classified in the Pastoral Group on the Imported Breed Register since 1 July 2025. The Pyrenean Mastiff (Imp) has been classified in the Working Group on the Imported Breed Register since 2001.

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Extended CC allocations for Jack Russell Terrier, Kooikerhondje and Lagotto Romagnolo

The Kennel Club is pleased to announce that, with effect from 2026, Jack Russell Terrier, Kooikerhondje and Lagotto Romagnolo will see their allocation of Challenge Certificates (CCs) extended from three to seven sets.

This decision follows the breeds' successful progress at introductory level and their meeting of the required criteria, including:

- An average of at least 15 exhibits entered annually over a three-year period at All-Breed Championship and relevant group shows
- A minimum of 28 judges registered at JEP Level 4
- Positive review of health, breeding lines, conformation, and judges' education, together with consideration of the number of dogs awarded CCs and champion titles

The Kennel Club celebrates first Rally Veteran Warrant (Bronze) award

The Kennel Club is delighted to announce the first recipient of the Rally Veteran Warrant (Bronze) award: Stillmoor Tartan Banner of Delphinia RW RVW(B), known at home as Delta, and owned and handled by Sue Brown.

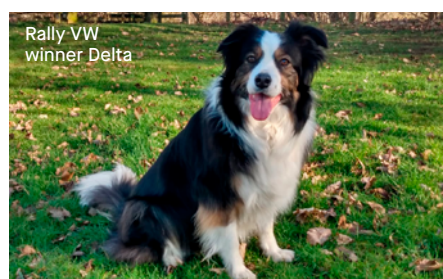
This award marks a significant milestone for both the rally community and for Delta, a Border Collie who began her rally career in 2018 and has since gone on to compete successfully at all levels. In June, Delta entered her first Veteran Rally class at the age of 7 and achieved both a score of 210 and 1st place, securing her Rally Veteran Warrant (Bronze).

Delta has also achieved her Rally Warrant and represented the Northern Rally Crufts Team in 2020 and 2024. She also takes part in agility and obedience and has gained The Kennel Club Good

Citizen Dog Training scheme's Gold Award.

Delta's owner, Sue Brown, said: "I am proud and honoured to have Delta as my first Border Collie, and from the moment she came home at 8 weeks old, I knew she was something special. We've enjoyed every moment of our rally journey, and I'm incredibly proud of her achievement in becoming the first dog in the UK to be awarded the Rally Veteran Warrant (Bronze)."

The Rally Veteran Warrant (RVW) was introduced earlier this year by The Kennel Club as part of its commitment to recognising lifelong participation in the discipline. The warrant is available to dogs aged 7 and over and is awarded at three levels – Bronze, Silver and Gold – based on qualifying scores achieved in Rally Veteran classes. Points can be

backdated to 1 January 2024.

Helen Kerfoot, Chief Canine Officer at The Kennel Club said: "The Rally Veteran Warrant was introduced to celebrate the commitment and strong partnerships seen in rally and Delta is a fantastic example of what this award is all about. The ability, enthusiasm and wonderful bond between Delta and Sue has been clear to see. We are thrilled to see the first RVW awarded and hope it inspires others to continue enjoying rally well into their dogs' veteran years."

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Agility Team GB secures series of medals at World Championship

Agility Team GB are celebrating a successful effort at the 2025 Agility World Championship (AWC), bringing home three medals – two silver and one bronze - across individual and team competitions.

The World Championship, which took place in Kalmar, Sweden, from 17 – 21 September, saw hundreds of handlers and dogs competing from 39 different countries across the globe.

Martin Reid, from Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, with his Shetland Sheepdog, Selfie (Ag Ch Get It With Eager To Work), won a silver medal in the Small Individual competition, while Shannon Springford, from Sittingbourne, Kent, and her Border Collie, Banter (Ag Ch Zhanisgo Give It Some Banter) also secured a silver medal in the Large Individual competition.

A bronze medal was also awarded to the Intermediate Team, made up of: Lee Gibson, from Shrewsbury, Shropshire, with his Border Collie, Star (Ag Ch Euro Star); Euan Paterson, from Stonehaven, Aberdeenshire, with his Border Collie, Crazee (Ag Ch Devongem Quick Time); Toni Smith, from Nottingham, with her Border Collie, Febe (Ag Ch Cherryhog Bright Future); and Steven Richardson, from Wigton, Cumbria, and his Border Collie, Gamble (Ag Ch Moel Gamble Demonic Risk).

Agility Team GB Manager, Greg Derrett said: "The AWC concludes another successful year for Agility Team GB achieving some phenomenal results in both the overall medals and class results. This group of handlers have continued to strive to improve, and it has been a pleasure to be their Team Manager.

"This year Agility Team GB has dominated the small with two golds, a silver and a 4th placing over the four

competitions. We have also won medals in all other heights and it's very pleasing that we are continuing to deliver results."

Agility Team GB consisted of 24 dogs, including reserves, who were selected following the try-out events which were held earlier in the year at Dog Sports Derby in March 2025.

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The Kennel Club welcomes passing of Housing (Scotland) Bill

The Kennel Club welcomes the recent passing of the Housing (Scotland) Bill, which includes important provisions that allow tenants to request to keep pets without being unreasonably refused by landlords.

This legislation marks a significant step forward in recognising the benefits of pet ownership for tenants across Scotland, promoting responsible pet ownership while safeguarding tenants' rights.

Holly Conway, Head of Public Affairs for The Kennel Club, said: "We are delighted that the Housing (Scotland) Bill has passed, which will ensure landlords cannot impose blanket bans on pets without just cause. Dogs, and other pets, can have such a positive impact on people's lives, particularly with their physical and mental wellbeing, and this legislation will help reduce barriers for tenants who want to keep a pet."

The Kennel Club updates RFG Scheme Crufts entry criteria for Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs

The Kennel Club has announced an update to the Respiratory Function Grading (RFG) Scheme entry criteria for Crufts 2026, as part of its commitment to monitoring and improving brachycephalic dog health.

From 2026 onwards, all Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, and Pugs with a Grade 2 or Grade 3 RFG Scheme assessment will not be eligible to attend Crufts. Previously, this exclusion applied only to Grade 3 dogs.

The RFG Scheme, developed by the University of Cambridge and The Kennel Club, assesses Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs for a breathing disorder, called brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome (BOAS). The assessment, which can be carried out by specially-trained assessors, involves listening to the dog's airway both before and after an exercise tolerance test. Assessors then use a pre-defined protocol to grade the dog from zero to three. Dogs graded as 0 will be free of respiratory signs of BOAS, while dogs graded as 3 will show severe respiratory signs of BOAS, indicating that further veterinary examination is advised.

All Crufts exhibitors of Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, and Pugs will be

required to upload an RFG Scheme certificate for dogs exceeding 14 calendar months to their Fosse Data account - certificates must be valid and up-to-date for the day of the show. Once uploaded, the certificate will be sent to The Kennel Club for validation. Exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible if their certificate has been approved or rejected. Certificates that have already been approved and remain in date do not need to be re-uploaded.

This year, international exhibitors will need to ensure their dog has an RFG Scheme assessment before entering. International RFG Scheme assessments issued by licensed organisations, and carried out by approved assessors, will be accepted. The Kennel Club is working closely with breed clubs and assessors both in the UK and internationally to ensure all dogs have the opportunity to be assessed under the Scheme ahead of entries closing.

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The Kennel Club introduces faster and more inclusive Liaison Council process

The Kennel Club is introducing an updated approach to how Liaison Councils operate across all Kennel Club licensed dog activities, including Agility, Obedience, Working Trials, Rally, and Heelwork to Music.

The improvements are designed to make the process faster, more flexible, and more accessible to grassroots participants, encouraging greater engagement and representation from the wider community.

Where previously, proposals could only be submitted in advance of scheduled Liaison Council meetings, under the new system participants can now submit suggestions at any time through a simple online form. Once a submission is received, it will be discussed before being added to a Council agenda. Urgent or straightforward matters may be addressed directly, while more complex proposals will be considered by the Councils and the wider community. This early discussion ensures each idea is clearly understood and properly considered. Council representatives will remain actively involved throughout the year via events, surveys, and social media. Representatives will be kept informed of submission dates and the items submitted, while participants will receive updates online to stay informed about progress and outcomes.

To support this new process, new Liaison Council representatives have been appointed across all five activity areas. These representatives bring a broader mix of experience, ensuring that the voices of both newcomers and seasoned participants are included in shaping the future of their disciplines. The appointments reflect a strong emphasis on practical, day-to-day involvement in activities as well as wider

expertise, promoting a balanced and inclusive approach to decision-making.

Another key change is the removal of regional boundaries for Council representatives. This means participants are no longer limited to engaging with representatives from a specific club or geographical area.

Anyone can now contact any Council representative directly, making it easier to offer feedback, raise concerns or suggest improvements, regardless of location. This increased flexibility is designed to strengthen connections between representatives and the wider community, and to foster broader collaboration across all activities.

Helen Kerfoot, Chief Canine Officer at The Kennel Club said: "These changes are a direct response following extensive feedback from participants, and will aim to speed up decision-making, improve transparency, encourage wider participation and ultimately reflect how people engage with their activities today."

"Liaison Councils are only as strong as the voices they represent, and, by making the process more agile and responsive, we want participants of all levels feel empowered to play an active role in shaping the future of our activities."

Participants can now submit proposals or ideas via the online form: thekennelclub.org.uk/forms/liaison-council-agenda-item/. Proposals should clearly outline the suggested change and how it would benefit the activity. All submissions will be reviewed

by The Kennel Club and relevant representatives and, if appropriate, shared with the wider community for discussion ahead of formal meetings.

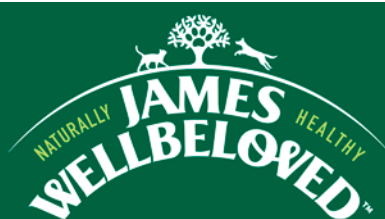

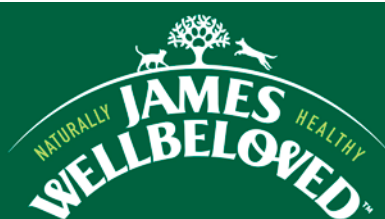

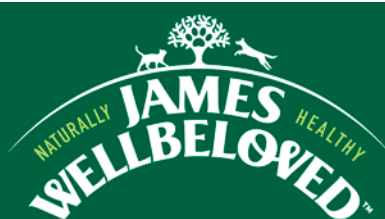

AMENDMENTS TO BREED STANDARDS

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendments:

BOSTON TERRIER

GENERAL APPEARANCE A small, smooth-coated, square-headed, compactly built, short-tailed and well-balanced dog. Body rather short, well knit, **and square in appearance**; limbs strong and neatly turned; tail short and no feature so prominent that the dog appears badly proportioned. Dog must convey an impression of strength and activity **without heaviness**, with a style of a high order and an easy and graceful carriage. **A sturdy dog, with bone and muscle in proportion so as to not appear to be either spindly or coarse. Style, body proportion, and basic shape consistent across the weight range.**

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS: Length of body from point of shoulder to point of buttock equal to height at withers. Depth of chest equal to half of height at withers. Length from stop to tip of nose approximately one-third of length of skull.

Characteristics Lively and intelligent.

TEMPERAMENT Lively, intelligent, determined and strong willed.

HEAD AND SKULL Skull square in appearance, flat on top, free from wrinkles; cheeks flat; brow abrupt with depth of foreface, stop well defined. Muzzle relatively short, square, wide, and deep; **filled under eyes** with no tendency to taper **to muzzle** and in proportion to skull; free from wrinkles; shorter in length than in width and depth. **Stop to tip of nose** approximately one-third of length of skull; width and depth of muzzle carried out to end; muzzle from stop to end of nose on a line parallel to top of skull; nose black, wide with well-defined line between nostrils. **Nostrils open.** Jaws broad and square. **Clean lip** of good depth but never pendulous and completely covering teeth when mouth closed. **Size of head to be in proportion to size of dog.**

EYES Set wide apart, **relatively large**, round, dark in colour. Eyes set square in skull and **forward facing**, outside corners on a line with cheeks when viewed from the front. **Excessively prominent eyes highly undesirable.** Expression alert, kind and intelligent.

EARS Small, thin, **triangular in shape with height slightly greater than width, tapering to tip. Mobile but carried erect and upright when alert, outer edge is situated as near corner of the skull as possible.**

NECK Of fair length, **displaying an image of balance to the whole dog**, slightly arched, carrying head gracefully, and neatly set into shoulders.

FOREQUARTERS Shoulders sloping **and well laid back**, legs **straight when viewed from front**, set moderately wide apart on line with point of shoulders; well-muscled; pasterns short and strong. Elbows turning neither in nor out.

BODY The length of back just short enough to square the body and the length from point of shoulder to point of buttock should equal height at withers. Level topline with croup that curves slightly to the set on of the tail. The chest is deep, well filled, and with good width; ribs deep and well sprung, carried well back; loin short and muscular; flank slightly cut up.

HINDQUARTERS Legs set true, **well-bent** stifle; hocks well let down; turning neither in nor out; thighs strong and well-muscled.

COLOUR Brindle: **being a mixture of any shade of brown and black** with white markings; brindle must show throughout body distinctly; black **or seal** with white markings **acceptable** but brindle with white markings preferred. **Seal appears black except it has a red cast when viewed in bright light.** Ideal markings: white muzzle **connected to** an even white blaze between the eyes, white collar, breast, part or whole of forelegs, and hindlegs below hocks. **A representative specimen should not be penalised for not possessing ideal markings.**

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

(Amendments in bold, deletions struck through)

CAIRN TERRIER

COLOUR Cream, wheaten, red, grey or nearly black. Brindling in all these colours acceptable. Dark points, such as ears and muzzle, very typical.

Any other colour or combination of colours, including solid black, white, or black and tan, unacceptable.

(Amendments in bold)

HAMILTONSTOVARE

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY Scent hounds have been known in Sweden since the 16th century. Hunting with hounds was up to 1789 a privilege for royalty and gentry only. It was not until the end of the 18th century that the ban that had prevented the peasantry from hunting the land was lifted. Hounds earlier kept only by the nobility became known and commonly spread. The origin of the Hamiltonstövare is believed to be a mixture of scent hounds from Southern Germany, Switzerland as well as Foxhounds and Harriers. At the first dog show in Sweden in 1886 some 189 scent hounds were on exhibition. Among them were a dog and a bitch, named Pang and Stella, owned by Count Adolf Patrik Hamilton. This couple is considered to be the origin of the Hamiltonstövare, or as the hounds initially were called, Swedish hound. The breed gained the name Hamiltonstövare in 1921 as a homage to the man that had created the breed, the founder of the Swedish Kennel Club, Count A.P. Hamilton.

GENERAL APPEARANCE Strikingly tricoloured, handsome, upstanding dog. Rectangular, well proportioned, **hardy and sound**. Gives the impression of great strength and stamina. **Never heavy. Clearly defined difference between the sexes.**

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS: Rectangular body and longish head. Depth of chest equal to half height at withers.

Characteristics Handsome, upstanding dog of striking colouring. Hardy and sound.

EYES Almond-shaped, dark brown with tranquil expression.

FOREQUARTERS Shoulders muscular and well laid back. When viewed from front forelegs appear straight and parallel. Upper arm long and **well-angulated to shoulder**. Elbows set close in to body.

BODY Back straight and powerful. Strong, broad,

muscular loin. **Slightly inclined croup of good length.** Chest deep, ribs moderately sprung, back ribs proportionately long. **Only very slight rise in underline.**

HINDQUARTERS Well angulated. Strong and parallel when viewed from behind. **Broad, well-muscled thighs.**

FEET Compact, oval, pointing straight forward with short well-arched toes. Pads well-developed and firm.

TAIL Set on low, **in line with croup**. Fairly wide at base, narrowing towards tip, reaching the hock.

Held straight or curving slightly in sabre-like shape. **Raised**, but not carried above the backline, when on the move.

COLOUR Tricolour.

On the adult dog black colour to form a mantle over body to continue on upper side of neck and upper side of tail.

Tan on head, ears, legs, sides of neck, shoulders, under body, thighs and underside of tail. Tan ranges from golden to a rich, deep, rusty red.

Lack of clear division between black and tan undesirable in an adult dog.

White colouring as a blaze on muzzle, on throat, brisket, tip of tail, lower part of legs and feet.

Large white markings on neck or full white collar undesirable. Lack of white markings highly undesirable.

None of the three colours should dominate. Characteristic breed colour pattern highly desirable.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

HUNGARIAN VIZSLA

COLOUR Russet gold, small white marks on chest and feet **permissible.**

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

(Amendments in bold)

IRISH RED AND WHITE SETTER

BODY Strong and muscular, deep chest and well sprung ribs. **Back from behind withers to croup level, not sloping. Croup well rounded, sloping slightly downwards to tailset.** Back and quarters very muscular and powerful. Bone strong, well built up with muscle and sinew.

KOOIKERHONDJE

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY Thought to date back to the 16th Century. In 1942, the Baroness Van Hardenbroek van Ammerstol began to recreate the Kooikerhondje. In 1966 the Raad van Beheer adopted the interim breed and in 1971 the breed was officially recognised. The Kooikerhondje was and still is used in the duck decoys. His task is still to lure the ducks into the decoy with his gaily

waving tail; he does not hunt the ducks. He calmly moves between the decoy screens in order to provoke the ducks' curiosity and lure them further down the decoy pipe where the ducks are captured in a trap.

GENERAL APPEARANCE A small, orange-red parti-coloured dog. High head carriage. An untrimmed coat with well-feathered tail.

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS: Almost square body, the length of the body from the point of the shoulder to the point of the buttocks slightly longer than the height at the withers. Skull and muzzle are of about equal length.

CHARACTERISTICS Temperament friendly, good-natured and alert. A sporting and companion dog whose purpose is to work as a duck decoy and control vermin. Self-confident, keen, swift and tough.

TEMPERAMENT Lively and agile, self-confident and with sufficient perseverance and stamina, good natured and alert, however not noisy. The breed is faithful, easy-going and friendly to known people, but aloof to strangers.

COLOUR Patches of clear orange-red on white with orange-red predominating on body. White blaze preferable. A few black hairs intermingling with the orange-red colour and slight ticking are acceptable but less desirable. A black tail ring, where the colour changes to white, acceptable.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

LAGOTTO ROMAGNOLO

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY Italian breed of waterfowl gundog in the lowlands of Comacchio and the marshlands of Ravenna in Romagna. Subsequently the Lagotto expanded its excellent working skills to include searching for truffles in the flat open country and in the hills of Romagna.

GENERAL APPEARANCE Squarely built, small to medium sized dog of rustic appearance; sturdy and robust with dense, curly coat of woolly texture. Noticeable difference between sexes.

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS: The dog is as high as it is long (square). The length of the head is 2/5 of the height at the withers. The length of the skull should be slightly more than the length of the muzzle. Length of leg from elbow to ground greater than depth of chest (about 56% of the height at the withers).

CHARACTERISTICS Ancient Italian breed of duck retriever, also used as a truffle hunter. Excellent watch dog and family companion.

TEMPERAMENT Lively, intelligent, affectionate. An excellent and alert family companion.

FOREQUARTERS Shoulders muscular, moderately well laid back, long in blade and equal in length to upper arm. Elbows fairly close fitting. Forearms straight with sturdy, oval bone. Wrist follows vertical line of forearm and is finer boned, robust and mobile. Pasterns sloping, elastic and slender compared to forearm.

BODY Compact and strong. Length of body from point of shoulder to point of buttock equal to height at withers. Withers set slightly apart and placed just above the line of the back. Straight topline falls

slightly from withers to croup. Loin short and wide. Croup long, wide, muscular and slopes gently. Well-developed chest reaches down to the elbows. Chest rather narrow in front, broadening behind the elbows. Slight tuck up. Skin thin, close fitting and without wrinkles.

COLOUR Solid off-white, white with brown or orange markings, orange roan, brown roan, brown (in different shades), solid orange, brown with white markings, orange with white markings. **Sable**, brown mask and tan markings **permissible**. Pigmentation ranges from light to very dark brown depending on coat colour.

Partial or total lack of pigmentation highly undesirable.

Any other colour, including black in any form, or combination of colours unacceptable.

NEAPOLITAN MASTIFF

FEET Large, round; toes well-arched and well-knit. Pads thick, hard and dark coloured. Nails curved, strong and dark. Hindfeet slightly smaller than front.

GAIT/MOVEMENT Slow and free. Long steps covering ground well. **Trot distinguished by strong thrust of hindquarters and good extension of forequarters. Topline held on the move. Rarely gallops. Pacing tolerated.**

SCHIPPERKE

TAIL Full length tail, tightly curled, carried over the back, well covered with hair. May be born visibly tailless or with partial length fully coated tail.

Previously customarily docked. Very short.

SCOTTISH TERRIER

EARS Neat, fine texture, pointed, erect and set on top of skull but not too close together. Large, wide-based ears **undesirable**.

COLOUR Black, wheaten or brindle of any shade.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER

HEAD AND SKULL Short, deep through with broad skull. Very pronounced cheek muscles, distinct stop, short foreface, **with a minimum ratio of 1 part muzzle to 2 parts skull**. Nose black or as dark as possible in blue dogs, with open nostrils.

BODY Close-coupled, with level topline, wide front, deep brisket, well-sprung ribs, **being rather light in loin**, muscular and well defined.

COLOUR White. Red, fawn, black, blue, or any one of these colours with white. Any shade of brindle or any shade of brindle with white.

Any other colour, including black and tan or liver, or combination of colours unacceptable.

(Amendments in bold)

SWEDISH VALLHUND

COLOUR All shades of grey and red with darker or black guard hairs. Lighter coat colour desirable on muzzle, throat, belly, buttocks, legs, feet and hocks. White markings permissible on chest, fore and hind legs, never to exceed one third of the total colour. White also permissible as a narrow blaze, neck spot or slight necklace.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

(Amendments in bold)

KENNEL CLUB RULE A11

Disciplinary Committee 28 August 2025

Mr Paul and Mrs Yvonne Bullivant Kennel Club Rule A11

The Committee having carefully considered the evidence, find that the complaint brought under Kennel Club Rule A11 a (1) (b) against Mr and Mrs Bullivant namely that they behaved discredibly or prejudicially to the interests of the canine world in that they were verbally abusive and were threatening towards Mr David Hawkes at the Edwinstowe Premier Open Show on 18 April 2025, is upheld.

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To warn them as to their future conduct [A11 j (1)]
2. To censure them [A11 j (2)]
3. To fine them £100.00 [A11 j (3)]
4. To disqualify them from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by The Royal Kennel Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be for the period of six (6) months from 22 September 2025.

The Committee, following the impositions of these penalties, would draw the attention of the Respondent to the effect of Rule A11 sub-sections l and n.

The Committee was in receipt of a number of testimonials on behalf of Mr and Mrs Bullivant attesting to their good character and their positive involvement generally in the canine show world and volunteering at Kennel Club licenced events.

The Committee noted the testimonials which were taken into account but found the admitted language and behaviour used by Mr and Mrs Bullivant towards Mr Hawkes to be troubling. The Committee, noting their significant experience in the canine world generally but especially at shows, felt Mr and Mrs Bullivant should have known better than to engage in such a way and ultimately despite their upset at the situation should have walked away to avoid escalation of any conflict between the parties.

The penalty imposed is intended to reflect that the behaviour exhibited was considered to be wholly unacceptable both in the context of Kennel Club licenced events and involvement in the canine world generally.

It is never acceptable in any circumstances to be verbally abusive and engage in a confrontational and threatening manner in the context of a licensed event (or indeed otherwise). If there are issues between parties, then that should be addressed outside the context of a licensed event – the only appropriate reaction within a licensed event is to walk away but never to solicit or engage in direct challenge or confrontation.

Rule A11 a (1) (b)

Any act or conduct which in the opinion of the Board is discreditable or prejudicial to the interests of the canine world and relates to or is connected with;

(b) the breeding, exhibition and judging of dogs, or any other canine activity

KENNEL CLUB RULE A12

Disciplinary Committee Hearing 28 August 2025

Elzbieta Tarnowska Kennel Club Rule A12

The Committee having carefully considered the convictions of Elzbieta Tarnowska of Dorking, Surrey for offences under the Animal Welfare Act 2006 from the Margate Magistrates' Court on 7 August 2024.

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To disqualify her from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by the Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]
2. To disqualify her from being or becoming a member of any canine club or society registered with or affiliated to the Kennel Club [A11 j (5)]
3. To disqualify her from acting as an Officer or serving on the Committee of any canine society [A11 j (6)]
4. To disqualify her from taking part in the management of any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (7)]
5. To disqualify her from judging at any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (8)]
6. To disqualify her from effecting registrations of any or all dogs and/or progeny of such dogs which are owned and/or registered by her (whether or not jointly owned and/or whether or not owned and/or registered in the name of a nominee) [A11 j (9)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be for five (5) years from 28 August 2025.

The Committee noted that Elzbieta Tarnowska pleaded not guilty to charges that between 07/04/2022 and 16/08/2023 carried on an activity described in section 13(2) of the Animal Welfare Act 2006, namely that she bred three or more litters of puppies in any 12-month period; and she bred dogs and advertised a business of selling dog for which a licence is required under the Animal Welfare (Licencing of Activities Involving Animals) without the authority of a licence for that purpose issued under section 13 of the Act. Contract to sections 13(6) and 32(2) of the Animal Welfare Act 2006.

The Committee noted that Elzbieta Tarnowska was found guilty and the Court imposed on her a Community Order requiring electronic monitoring and subject to curfew for four months. She was also ordered to pay a victim surcharge of £114.00 and costs of £620.00.

Ms Tarnowska responded to the referral. This was a case of confluence of factors which tipped Ms Tarnowska over the threshold for the breeding licensing required. There was already a litter being cared for, another planned litter due and on importing a dog from Poland that was found to be pregnant. There appear to be indications that the home had been adapted to house a large number of dogs.

The Committee's view was that a breeder must ensure that they are fully informed about the breeding licensing requirements and appropriately plan so that they do not breach the requirements – and seek help and advice, perhaps from other breeders or sources of authority.

As the Local Authority commented; having a licence means that dog breeders understand what is expected of them and helps to ensure animals in their care are being correctly looked after.

The objectives which are relevant when making a decision under Rule 12 include:

- the conviction involves conduct prejudicial and discreditable to the interests of the canine world
- to penalise if necessary
- to issue a deterrent to that individual and others
- to issue a marker of seriousness of incident to the canine world
- the protection of the welfare of dogs
- the credibility and standing of Kennel Club/canine activities and the desirability of participation of the convicted person in such activities.

In the context of licensing convictions, the Committee is going to review the following aspects:

- The court sentence/disqualification orders
- Previous reminders by councils if given and ignored
- Deliberate flouting or inadvertent
- Volume if breeding and use of Kennel Club registrations
- Welfare issues

The Kennel Club does not consider it acceptable not to need to (or to be ignorant of the need to) comply with the law and not to allow for oversight and controls over animal husbandry and scrutiny of breeding practices via the Local Authority licensing.

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particularly if engaged in breeding at levels which exceed the threshold for requiring a licence.

It is undermining of responsible breeders who do take the time and trouble and deploy resources to submit themselves to statutory scrutiny via Local Authority Licensing requirements.

The Committee's view was that a five (5) year disqualification from Kennel Club regulated activities is appropriate to reflect the seriousness of the matter.

Disciplinary Committee 28 August 2025 Steven Robson Kennel Club Rule A12

The Committee having carefully considered the convictions of Steven Robson of Bingley, West Yorkshire for offences under The Animal Welfare Act 2026 from the Crown Court at Bradford on 5 November 2024.

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To disqualify him from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by the Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]
2. To disqualify him from being or becoming a member of any canine club or society registered with or affiliated to the Kennel Club [A11 j (5)]
3. To disqualify him from acting as an Officer or serving on the Committee of any canine society [A11 j (6)]
4. To disqualify him from taking part in the management of any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (7)]
5. To disqualify him from judging at any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (8)]
6. To disqualify him from effecting registrations of any or all dogs and/or progeny of such dogs which are owned and/or registered by him (whether or not jointly owned and/or whether or not owned and/or registered in the name of a nominee) [A11 j (9)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be for Life from 28th August 2025.

The Committee noted that Steven Robson was found guilty of carrying on an activity without the authority of a s.13 licence and the Court imposed on him an 18-month community order with a curfew 8pm to 8am for 6 months. The Court also imposed a life disqualification in respect of all animals from dealing with them which he cannot apply to lift for a period of 10 years.

Mr Robson responded to the referral. This was a case where Mr Robson was repeatedly made aware of the need for a breeding licence by Bradford Council. Mr Robson did not obtain the necessary breeding licence despite continuing to breed dogs.

The Committee also noted the severe penalties which Mr Robson is subject to including his lifetime ban from dealing with animals.

The objectives which are relevant when making a decision under Rule 12 include:

- the conviction involves conduct prejudicial and discreditable to the interests of the canine world
- to penalise if necessary
- to issue a deterrent to that individual and others
- to issue a marker of seriousness of incident to the canine world
- the protection of the welfare of dogs
- the credibility and standing of Kennel Club/canine activities and the desirability of participation of the convicted person in such activities.

In the context of licensing convictions, the Committee is going to review the following aspects:

- The court sentence/disqualification orders
- Previous reminders by councils if given and ignored
- Deliberate flouting or inadvertent
- Breeding volumes and use of Kennel Club registrations
- Welfare issues

The Kennel Club does not consider it acceptable not to allow for oversight and controls over animal husbandry and scrutiny of breeding practices via Local Authority licensing, particularly if engaged in breeding at levels which exceed the threshold for requiring a licence.

It is undermining of responsible breeders who do take the time and trouble and deploy resources to submit themselves to statutory scrutiny via Local Authority Licensing requirements.

The Committee's view was that a lifetime disqualification from Kennel Club regulated activities is appropriate to reflect the seriousness of the matter.

Disciplinary Committee 28 August 2025 Louise Keenan Kennel Club Rule A12

The Committee having carefully considered the convictions of Louise Keenan of Guildford, Surrey for offences under the Animal Welfare Act 2006 from the Staines Magistrates Court on 4 May 2023 (sentenced in the Crown Court at Guildford on 8 April 2025).

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To disqualify her from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by the Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]
2. To disqualify her from being or becoming a member of any canine club or society registered with or affiliated to the Kennel Club [A11 j (5)]
3. To disqualify her from acting as an Officer or serving on the Committee of any canine society [A11 j (6)]
4. To disqualify her from taking part in the management of any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (7)]
5. To disqualify her from judging at any event licensed by the Club [A11 j (8)]
6. To disqualify her from effecting registrations of

any or all dogs and/or progeny of such dogs which are owned and/or registered by her (whether or not jointly owned and/or whether or not owned and/or registered in the name of a nominee) [A11 j (9)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be for Life from 28 August 2025.

The Committee noted that Louise Keenan was found guilty of carrying on an activity without the authority of a s.13 licence and that the Court imposed on her a sentence of 2 months imprisonment suspended for 12 months and ordered her to pay compensation of £13.00 each to three victims and to pay a Victim Surcharge of £154.00.

The Committee noted a co-defendant of the same address was handed a sentence of 2 months imprisonment suspended for 12 months and was ordered to pay costs of £25,000, compensation of £5,900 and was disqualified from keeping dogs for five years.

Ms Keenan responded to the referral.

Ms Keenan in her mitigation said that the situation had occurred inadvertently due to adoption/rescue of pregnant dogs during the Covid pandemic. Whether Ms Keenan had deliberately or inadvertently chosen not to submit herself to the control of the licensing authorities when breeding at levels requiring a licence was a source of considerable concern.

The objectives which are relevant when making a decision under Rule 12 include:

- the conviction involves conduct prejudicial and discreditable to the interests of the canine world
- to penalise if necessary
- to issue a deterrent to that individual and others
- to issue a marker of seriousness of incident to the canine world
- the protection of the welfare of dogs
- the credibility and standing of Kennel Club/canine activities and the desirability of participation of the convicted person in such activities.

In the context of licensing convictions, the Committee will review the following aspects:

- The court sentence/disqualification orders
- Whether previous reminders have been given by councils and/or disregarded
- Deliberate flouting or inadvertent the licensing requirements
- Breeding volumes and use of Kennel Club registrations
- Welfare issues

The Kennel Club does not consider it acceptable to be ignorant of the law and not to allow for oversight and controls over animal husbandry and scrutiny of breeding practices, particularly if engaged in breeding at levels which exceed the threshold for requiring a licence.

It is undermining of responsible breeders who do take the time and trouble and deploy resources to submit themselves to statutory scrutiny via Local Authority Licensing requirements.

The Committee's view was that a lifetime disqualification from Kennel Club regulated activities is appropriate to reflect the seriousness of the matter.
