The move reflects Crufts' ongoing commitment to the younger generation within the dog world.

Hall 8 will also play host to brand-new dog grooming competitions, showcasing the artistry and precision of top grooming talent from across the UK and around the world. These contests promise to be a visual spectacle and a celebration of the skill and flair that define the dog grooming profession.

Further details of the dog grooming competitions will be announced in the coming weeks.

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Tamworth MP's dog crowned winner at Westminster Dog of the Year

There were celebrations in Westminster on 11 September as Poykee, a 13-year-old Keeshond, owned by Sarah Edwards, Labour MP for Tamworth, emerged victorious after being crowned the winner at the Westminster Dog of the Year competition.



The annual competition, organised by The Kennel Club and Dogs Trust, took place in Victoria Tower Gardens, in the shadow of the Houses of Parliament, and provided an opportunity for MPs to engage with experts to discuss all aspects of dog welfare. This year, the event highlighted the vital role that dogs play in any household, the importance of the human-animal bond and the joys that dog ownership brings. Topics raised include pet-friendly housing, responsible dog ownership, breeding, training and socialisation, all of which can ensure that dogs live happy and healthy lives.

Winning MP, Sarah Edwards, said of the pair's success: "It's really amazing. I was hoping that we had a chance – certainly I've been gearing Poykee up and making sure that he dazzled the judges and his personality shines through.

"We've been doing prep work ahead of the day, making sure that he really promotes what it is to be a fabulous pet but also a creature with a really individual personality as well. We've been out and

about in Tamworth talking to people and thinking about how we can promote the fabulousness of dogs, but also how important they are as our family pets."

Jannine Edgar, Chief Executive of The Kennel Club, said: "Well done to Poykee, alongside Sarah Edwards MP, on being crowned Westminster Dog of the Year 2025. There was strong competition this year, with some truly heartwarming relationships between dogs and their owners, so they should be very proud of their achievement.

"It has been a pleasure to judge this year's competition.

Westminster Dog of the Year celebrates our four-legged friends and provides a fantastic opportunity to raise

awareness of issues affecting dog welfare, and so I'd like to thank all the MPs and their canine companions for taking part today."

Claire Calder, Head of Public Affairs at Dogs Trust added: "Congratulations to Poykee and Sarah Edwards MP on their well-deserved win at Westminster Dog of the Year 2025. It's been a joy to see such a wide variety of dogs take centre

stage, each one clearly loved by their MP and demonstrating the important role dogs play as members of the family.

"Events like this are more than just fun – they're a chance to highlight the connection between people and their dogs, and to promote key messages around animal welfare and responsible dog ownership. Thank you to all the MPs who took the time to celebrate their canine companions on the day."

Runners-up in this year's Westminster Dog of the Year were rescue dog Mabel and Becky Gittins, Labour MP for Clwyd East, who won second place, and office dog Lucy, a Labrador, with Andrew Snowden, Conservative MP for Fylde, who won third place. The pair were chosen by the judging panel, comprised of Jannine Edgar, Chief Executive of The Kennel Club, Jayne Whitton, Chief Marketing and Communications Officer at Dogs Trust, and 2023 Westminster Dog of the Year winner, Mims Davies MP. In addition to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards, the competition also had a winner decided solely from the public – via the Sir David Amess Public Vote – which was 6-year-old Guide Dog, Jennie, owned by Steve Darling, Lib Dem MP for Torbay.

The Kennel Club announces closure of Bark and Read

The Kennel Club and The Kennel Club Educational Trust have announced the closure of the Bark and Read Alliance, after more than a decade of helping children thrive with reading through their connection with dogs.

Since the initiative launched in 2012, canine-assisted reading programmes in the UK have evolved from a small number of dedicated individuals and groups operating independently, which Bark and Read provided direct grant aid for, to larger canine therapy charities joining the initiative who could provide training, assessment frameworks and fundraising support for independent volunteers.

To help unite these individuals and organisations, The Kennel Club developed the Bark and Read Standards of Practice; a shared document that brought together all the experience, insights and values across the initiative partners into a single, practical guide, while also hosting reading sessions on the dedicated stand at Crufts, welcoming volunteers and their dogs to represent their charities.

The initiative has now surpassed the original goal of promoting

canine-assisted literacy support in schools, within a framework that benefits both dogs and children, and the decision has been made to step back from this field, to enable these organisations, who are more specialised in this area, to continue to provide these services.

Ciara Farrell, Culture and Heritage Senior Manager at The Kennel Club, said: "We are immensely proud of Bark and Read and what we have achieved, alongside our dedicated partner organisations. This has not been an easy decision but, given the outstanding dedication and commitment of our partners, we're confident they will not only continue this work, but will help canine-assisted literacy support to thrive."

"On behalf of The Kennel Club, we would like to thank every volunteer and dog who has joined us over the past 13 years. It has been a joyful experience and we have truly valued their support."

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The Kennel Club launches development register to support Leonberger genetic diversity

The Kennel Club has announced the launch of a Development Register, designed to support health-focused, breeder-led initiatives aimed at improving genetic diversity within pedigree breeds.

The Development Register has been introduced specifically for the Leonberger, in collaboration with LeoGen, an international group of breeders who have developed a structured outcross programme to address concerns over genetic bottlenecks in the breed.

A restricted gene pool can, over time, lead to increased incidence of disease and the rate of loss of genetic diversity must be kept at sustainable levels to avoid population decline. The Kennel Club, which collects dog health data and develops evidence-based tools to help breeders to make responsible, informed decisions, historically operated an open registry system that permitted controlled outcrossing when necessary, and this new Development Register seeks to carefully reintroduce this principle in a health-driven, evidence-based manner.

The Leonberger Development Register (LDR) will operate alongside, but separately from, the existing Breed Register. Its purpose is to provide a structured pathway for the inclusion of carefully selected outcrossed dogs into the breed population.

The LDR will allow the registration of progeny resulting from controlled

outcrosses between Leonbergers and other selected breeds or landraces, as part of the LeoGen programme. These dogs will be registered under the Leogenz kennel name. All dogs within the LDR must undergo the full suite of

health testing required for their parent breed(s), ensuring they meet the health standard for the breed.

Individual dogs from the LDR may be considered for transfer to The Kennel Club Breed Register once they reach maturity.

This process will involve demonstration of clear health results, independent assessment by two championship judges, and a staged registration system: transferred dogs will carry a *** designation; their offspring will carry **, etc. This tiered approach allows careful monitoring of the impact of outcrosses on breed health and conformation.

"The Kennel Club is committed to safeguarding the long-term health of pedigree dogs, and this Development Register is an important step in enabling responsible, breeder-led initiatives that put health first," said Dr Joanna Iliska, Geneticist at The Kennel Club. "By working in partnership with LeoGen and the wider Leonberger community, we are creating a framework that

allows carefully managed outcrossing to strengthen the genetic base of the breed while maintaining welfare and breed type."

The Development Register reflects The Kennel Club's commitment to enabling breeders to take evidence-based, health-focused initiatives to protect and improve their breeds' future. By developing this register in partnership with LeoGen, it aims to support genetic stewardship while maintaining high welfare and conformation standards.

The Kennel Club will monitor how the development register is working with breeders and its Health and Breeding Team to evaluate its outcomes. Learnings from the Leonberger Development Register will help shape future approaches to maintaining healthy, sustainable breed populations.

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Eased travel rules introduced for Northern Irish dog owners heading to shows

The Kennel Club has welcomed new changes to the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) policy regarding the movements of animals travelling to shows, competitions, and events, which will simplify the process for Northern Irish dog owners.

Previously, anyone travelling to dog shows from Northern Ireland to Great Britain, were subject to the full requirements of Council Regulation (EC) No 1/2005 as implemented by the Welfare of Animals (Transport) Regulations (NI) 2006, because it had been deemed that the transport was 'in connection with an economic activity'. As part of this, Council Regulation (EC) No 1/2005 places a number of requirements on the 'animal transporter', including obtaining a valid transporter authorisation, and, potentially, certificates of competence and vehicle approval.

DAERA has now revised its policy position and, from 1 October 2025, the following will be exempt from the Regulation that has previously classed these as an economic activity:

- Pet animals that are transported by their owner on a private journey
- Pet animals, e.g. dogs and cats, taken to or from a specialist show or competition and the primary purpose is for pleasure rather than part of a business
- Individuals attending shows or

competitions primarily for pleasure who share the burden of transport, e.g. petrol costs, but there is no profit made by the individual undertaking the transport

Dr Ed Hayes, Head of Public Affairs at The Kennel Club, said: "We know that the current travel regulations have placed a significant burden on dog show exhibitors, and we have called

on DAERA for a number of years to reconsider their policy. We are therefore delighted that DAERA has listened to these concerns and ensured that those travelling from Northern Ireland to Great Britain can enjoy their hobby without unnecessary, additional hurdles."

INTERIM BREED STANDARDS

Hungarian Mudi (Imp)

At its recent meeting, the Board approved an interim breed standard for the Hungarian Mudi (Imp). This is with effect from 1 October 2025.

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY A herding breed used for herding large livestock and flushing wild boar. Excellent guard and companion dog. Developed in 18th to 19th century from Hungarian herding dogs and various prick-eared German herding dogs.

GENERAL APPEARANCE Medium-sized. Wedge-shaped head with erect ears. Topline slopes slightly towards rear. Head and front of limbs covered by short, smooth coat. Other parts of body have longer, very wavy to slightly curly coat. The breed comes in various colours.

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS Length of body from point of shoulder to point of buttock, very slightly greater than height at withers.

Depth of chest 40-45% of height at withers.

Length of skull to length of muzzle in the ratio of 3:2.

TEMPERAMENT Intelligent, lively, courageous, watchful, and keen to work. Active and adaptable. Aggressive or overly shy behaviour unacceptable.

HEAD AND SKULL Head properties of utmost importance. Gives impression of an alert, always ready to work, intelligent animal without any trace of shyness or aggressiveness.

Head wedge-shaped, tapering evenly towards nose. Skull and forehead slightly domed. Superciliary ridges slightly developed. Minimal stop. Muzzle moderately strong. Bridge of nose straight. Nose narrow, rounded at front with moderately wide nostrils. Occiput not pronounced.

Nose colour generally black, except for brown and merle where nose colour brown; and blue and blue merle where nose colour blue. Fawn and white: black nose preferable but blue and brown acceptable. Spotted or flesh-coloured nose leather highly undesirable.

EYES Almond shape, set slightly oblique. As dark as possible. In merle colours, partially or solid blue eye colour (in either or both eyes) permissible. Yellow eyes in black dogs highly undesirable. Eyelids tight, close-fitting to eyeball, evenly pigmented.

EARS V-shaped, set on high and held erect. Slightly longer than width at base. In length, slightly less than half length of head. Covered with abundant hair reaching beyond edges of external ears. Ears can turn independently of each other with very lively response to stimulation. Drop ears highly undesirable.

MOUTH Jaws strong with perfect, regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws. Medium size teeth. Lips tight-fitting to teeth. Lip pigment corresponds with pigment of nose-leather.

NECK Medium length, slightly arched, well-muscled. Set on slightly high. No dewlap or pronounced neck ruff. Male dogs may have a barely developed mane; this should never be prominent.

FOREQUARTERS Shoulders moderately sloping, well-muscled. Withers pronounced. Upper arm of

medium length. Forechest curved, not prominent. Elbows close fitting to body.

Wrist firm, dry and tight. Pastern steep.

BODY Slightly longer in body than height at withers. Back straight, medium length with topline slightly sloping to croup. Loin short and firmly coupled. Croup short, medium breadth, slightly sloping and muscular. Ribbing broad and rather flat. Depth of chest less than half of height at withers, and reaching to elbow. Underline rises to slightly tucked-up belly.

HINDQUARTERS Moderate hind angulation. Upper thigh long and well-muscled. Low set hocks.

FEET Feet round, with well-knit toes. Pads springy. Nails slate grey and hard. Minimal hair between and under toes.

TAIL Any length, from naturally tailless to full tail. Set on medium height. Abundantly coated.

In repose, hanging, with lower third raised almost to horizontal. When alert and during active movement, tail carried in sickle shape, above the topline.

GAIT/MOVEMENT Characteristic movement: Mincing steps, with vigorous trot and powerful gallop.

COAT On body, coat uniformly very wavy or slightly curly. Dense and always shiny. Never wiry. Length 3 - 7 cms (1¼ - 2¾ins). Some cowlicks and ridges are formed. Head and front of legs covered by short, straight, smooth hair. Coat longest on back of forelimbs, upper thighs and underside of tail, giving pronounced featherings. Skin tight, without wrinkles.

COLOUR Black, white, fawn (from beige to red), blue, brown, blue-brown (diluted brown/Isabella), merle in these colours.

White markings, including small patch on chest (less than 5 cms / 2 ins) or some white on toes tolerated.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable

SIZE Height at withers:

Males: 43 - 45cms (17 - 17¾ins). Females: 40 - 42cms (15¾ - 16½ins). 2cms variation either side tolerated.

FAULTS Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog.

NOTE Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.

Pyrenean Mastiff (Imp)

At its recent meeting, the Board approved an interim breed standard for the Pyrenean Mastiff (Imp). This is with effect from 1 October 2025.

BRIEF HISTORICAL SUMMARY Previously used for defence against predators, in particular wolf and bear. Nowadays an excellent guard for country estates and their owners as he is easily trained.

GENERAL APPEARANCE Very large. Strong and muscular. Solid bone. Coat should not be exaggerated in length. In spite of their size, should not give impression of being slow or sluggish.

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS Length of body from point of shoulder to point of buttock slightly greater than height at withers.

Length of skull to length of muzzle in the ratio of 5:4

Breadth of skull equal to or slightly greater than length of skull

Height at withers to girth of chest in ratio of approximately 7:10

TEMPERAMENT Friendly towards people, calm, noble and intelligent. Courageous and confident towards strangers, never backing away. Good-natured towards other animals, and aware of his great size. Can and will guard and protect only when necessary.

HEAD AND SKULL Large and strong, moderately long. Length of skull slightly longer than muzzle. Planes of skull and muzzle only slightly diverging or almost parallel. Viewed from above, skull and muzzle long and even in shape. No marked difference between width at set-on of muzzle and width of skull.

Viewed from side, head deep. Skull convex in profile, not bulging.

Width of skull equal to or slightly greater than length. Pronounced occiput. Gentle stop, barely perceptible but still visible.

Viewed from side, muzzle straight. Viewed from above tapering very gradually to nose. Not pointed.

Nose black, large and broad. Lips black. Upper lip covers lower with no hint of slackness.

EYES Relatively small, almond-shaped, hazel in colour. Darker eyes preferable.

Expression alert, noble, sympathetic, and intelligent. Can be extraordinarily stern towards an opponent.

Eye lids black. Close fitting, particularly when alert.

EARS Medium size, triangular, set just above level of eyes. Hanging flat. When alert, clearly standing away from cheeks.

MOUTH Jaws strong with a perfect, regular and complete scissor bite, i.e. upper teeth closely overlapping lower teeth and set square to jaws.

NECK Broad, strong, muscular and flexible. In shape a blunt cone. Skin thick, relatively loose. Distinct double dewlap, well-formed, but not exaggerated.

FOREQUARTERS Viewed from front, forelegs straight and parallel. Good bone. Shoulder sloping and slightly longer than upper arm. Well-angled shoulder. Elbows closely fitting to ribcage. Pasterns slightly sloping.

BODY Slightly longer from sternum to point of buttock than height at withers. Powerful and robust, giving impression of great strength, yet supple and agile. Topline straight when standing and moving. Back strong and muscular. Loins broad and strong. Height at croup should be equal to height at withers. Chest broad and deep. Well-developed forechest. Ribbing well-rounded. Underline moderately tucked up, Broad at flanks.

HINDQUARTERS Powerful and muscular with moderate angulation. Upper thigh strong and muscular. Lower thigh long, well-muscled, with good bone. Dewclaws single, double or absent. Double dewclaws preferable.

FEET Well-knit, cat feet. Toes well-arched. Well-developed nails. Firm pads. Rear feet slightly longer than front feet.

TAIL Set on medium high. Thick at root, strong and

flexible. Coat on tail longer than body. In repose hangs low and reaches hock. Last third slightly curved. When moving and alert, carried like a sabre, but not over back.

GAIT/MOVEMENT Harmonious, strong, elegant, without tendency for legs to swing outward.

Hindquarters provide easy, forceful drive.

COAT Dense, thick and of moderate length. Ideally 6 to 9cm when measured on middle section of topline. Coat longer on shoulders, neck, under belly, at back of legs and on tail. Bristly, not woolly in texture.

COLOUR Base colour pure white, always with a well-defined mask. Irregularly-distributed, distinctly-outlined patches of same colour as mask may occur. Colour of patches, in order of preference: medium grey; intense golden yellow; brown; black; grey silver; light beige; sandy; marbled. Red patches and yellowish-white base colour undesirable. Tricolour or pure white dogs undesirable. Ears always spotted. Tip of tail and lower parts of legs always white. At roots, coat as light as possible, ideally white.

Any other colour or combination of colours unacceptable.

SIZE No upper size limit. When of equal quality, larger dog preferred.

Minimum sizes

Dogs 77cms (30¼ins)

Bitches 72 cms (28¼ins)

FAULTS Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog.

NOTE Male animals should have two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.
